This conveyance is expressly made subject and subordinate to all validly existing restrictions, covenants, conditions, rights-of-way, easements, ordinances, maintenance charges and liens securing said charges, mineral reservations, and royalty reservations, or record, if any, affecting all or any party of the premises.




