Whereas, **SUGAR LAND CULTURAL ARTS FOUNDATION** has signed a resolution of support for said cultural district and,


Whereas, the Texas Commission on the Arts will be petitioned to designate said cultural district and,


Whereas, this Resolution serves a public purpose.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Fort Bend County Commissioners Court:


- Article 1. Endorses the submission of this application of said cultural district;

- Article 5. By this action, requests all residents of county and especially those citizens who own property or businesses within said cultural district to support, promote and help maintain activities and events in said district.


