THIRD AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT PROJECT NO. 718 & 769 – BRAND LANE

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT is made and entered into by and between FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, a public body corporate and politic of the State of Texas acting by and through the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court (hereinafter referred to as "County") and SES HORIZON CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC., (hereinafter referred to as "Engineer,") authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on or about June 10, 2008, County and Engineer entered a Professional Engineering Services Agreement, hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement," a First Amendment on February 2, 2010, (hereinafter referred to as "First Amendment,") and a Second Amendment on September 6, 2011, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Amendment") for the expansion of Brand Lane, Project No. 718 & 769, located in Fort Bend County, Texas, as part of the 2007 Fort Bend County Mobility Programs, hereinafter referred to as the "Project;" and,

WHERAS, County and Engineer desire to amend the Agreement to provide for additional services and extend the time for performance as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the Agreement between County and Engineer is hereby amended as follows:

AGREEMENT

- 1. Engineer shall provide the services as described in Exhibit A, Letter from Schaumburg & Polk, Inc. dated April 26, 2013.
- 2. An additional amount not-to-exceed \$99,437.00 shall be available for services provided for the Project as described in Exhibit A. The amount paid to Engineer for services provided shall not exceed \$790,437.00, including all expenses, if any, as follows:
 - A. \$650,000.00 for services under the Agreement;
 - B. \$-0- under the First Amendment (time extension only)
 - C. \$41,000.00 for additional services under the Second Amendment
 - D. \$99,437.00 for additional services under this Third Amendment.
- 3. This Third Amendment shall extend the time for Engineer to provide approved services for the Project until December 31, 2014.
- 4. No additional funding shall be available for services provided under the Agreement, First & Second Amendment or this Third Amendment without prior written consent of the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court.

- 5. Except as modified herein, the Agreement, First & Second Amendment remain in full force and effect and has not been modified or amended.
- 6. Attached hereto is Exhibit A letter from Schaumburg & Polk, Inc. dated April 26, 2013 regarding additional services. The Agreement, First & Second Amendment are incorporated by reference as if set forth therein verbatim for all purposes.
- 7. If there is a conflict between this Third Amendment and the Agreement, First & Second Amendment, the provisions of this Third Amendment shall prevail.

Contract Amendment for SES Horizon Consulting Engineers, Inc.

Dear Mr. Stolleis:

Several tasks have been added to the Brand Lane project that were not included in the original scope of work for SES Horizon. These tasks include the following:

- Inclusion of a Fort Bend WCID No. 2 water line into the pavement reconstruction plans. The
 County and WCID 2 agreed to include the water line into the pavement plans, subject to full
 reimbursement to the County by WCID 2. The interlocal agreement, which is being prepared,
 will include reimbursement to the County of SES Horizon's fee of \$23,512.00 for design and
 coordination efforts.
- Revision of the storm sewer to reflect recent changes to the Stafford Run model. The Fort Bend
 County Drainage District recently completed a new model of the channel, resulting in a lower
 water surface elevation. SES Horizon is requesting an additional fee of \$50,925.00 to revise their
 hydraulic calculations and drawings. SES Horizon estimates that the revised storm sewer will
 result in a construction cost savings to the County of approximately \$257,000.
- Construction phase services. These services were not included in the original contract, but construction is imminent. SPI recommends an addition of \$25,000.00 for these services, to be billed on a time-and-materials basis.

Adding these tasks and associated fees requires a contract amendment for SES Horizon. The total amount of the amendment, based on the three items above, is recommended to be \$99,437.00. This amendment will result in a total contract amount of \$790,437.00. SPI also recommends that the contract termination date be extended to be December 31, 2014.
