SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES

County and Architect desire to amend said Agreement as set forth in Architect's proposal dated May 13, 2013, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth verbatim.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the Agreement between County and Architect is hereby amended to read:

- A. An additional amount not-to-exceed \$19,940.00 shall be available for additional services provided by Architect in connection with the Project as described in Exhibit A.
- B. Architect's compensation for the Project shall not exceed \$266,880.00, which includes the original scope of work under the Agreement in the amount of \$244,300.00, additional services in the amount of \$2,640.00 under the First Amendment, and services provided under this Second Amendment.
- C. No additional funding shall be available for services provided under the Agreement without prior written consent of the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court.
- D. Except as modified herein, the Agreement remains in full force and effect and has not been modified or amended.
- E. If there is a conflict between this Second Amendment and the Agreement and First Amendment, the provisions of this Second Amendment shall prevail.
