





Dear Commissioner Patterson and Mr. Ortega:

DCH is a contractor that has been working on behalf of Riverstone Development to manage materials within the community. Recently, DCH has consulted with the County to cross University Boulevard with off-road trucks transporting fill material. This crossing will be perpendicular to University to limit the area impacted. Efforts to mitigate any effects will include flagmen directing traffic at all times while the trucks are in circulation, rock entrances placed on both sides of the crossing limiting the amount of dirt tracked into the pavement and also the streets will be swept daily, as needed, to keep them clean and control the dust. Lastly, once all activities have commenced, Riverstone agrees to repair and restore University Boulevard to its current condition.

As discussed prior, the purpose of this letter is to replace the Performance Bond which the County typically requires before issuing a permit for such work. Thank you for your consideration in this matter.
