RESOLUTION APPOINTING DIRECTOR OF
THE FORT BEND COUNTY TOLL ROAD AUTHORITY

(the "Resolution") was duly introduced for the consideration of the Commissioners Court and reviewed in full. It was then duly moved by Comm. Meyers and seconded by Comm. Morrison that the Resolution be passed; and, after due discussion, the motion, carrying with it the passage of the Resolution, prevailed and carried by the following vote:

 The County Judge thereupon announced that the Resolution has been duly and lawfully adopted. The Resolution thus adopted follows:

RESOLUTION APPOINTING DIRECTOR OF
THE FORT BEND COUNTY TOLL ROAD AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Fort Bend County Toll Road Authority (the "Authority") was duly created and its Board of Directors organized; and

WHEREAS, the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws of the Authority were approved by the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court and the Articles of Incorporation have been filed with the Secretary of State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Articles of Incorporation of the Authority, five members were appointed to serve on the Board of Directors of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Articles of Incorporation of the Authority, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas shall fill any vacancy in the Board of Directors by appointment in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation or the Bylaws; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas desires to appoint William D. Kee, III to serve on the Board of Directors of the Authority for the lawful term of office or until his successor shall be appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, William D. Kee, III is over twenty-one years of age, a resident citizen of the State of Texas, otherwise qualified by law to serve as a Director of the Authority, and not disqualified from serving as a Director of the Authority by any reason of law;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT THAT:

Section 1. William D. Kee, III is hereby appointed as Director of Fort Bend County Toll Road Authority to serve in that capacity until January 22, 2016, or until his successor shall be appointed and qualified.

Section 2. A copy of the Resolution shall be recorded in the minutes of this Court.

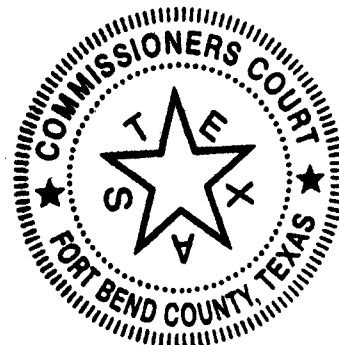

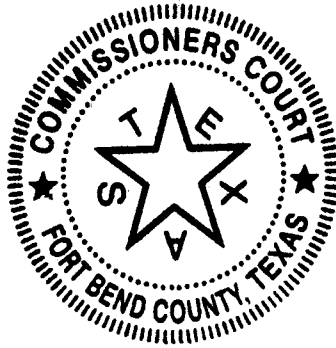
