ORDER TO ABANDON 60 FOOT BY 887 FOOT DRAINAGE EASEMENT LOCATED ON PROPERTY OWNED BY JIMMY CALHOUN AND WIFE, CHARLOTTE CALHOUN, IN FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS

On this <u>'o</u> day of <u>August</u>, 2013, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, sitting as the governing body Fort Bend County, Texas, upon motion of Commissioner MARYISON seconded by Commissioner duly put and carried, by unanimous vote, Commissioners Court adopts the resolution to abandon a 60 foot by 887 foot drainage easement located on real property owned by Jimmy Calhoun and wife, Charlotte Calhoun and located perpendicular to Hartledge Road in Fort Bend County, Texas.

The names of each property owner who owns the underlying fee simple interest of the property burdened with the drainage easement described herein are Jimmy Calhoun and wife, Charlotte Calhoun.

The dimensions of the 60 foot by 887 foot drainage easement abandoned are described in Exhibit A of the Resolution, incorporated herein for all purposes, and indexed by the County Clerk into the real property records of Fort Bend County, Texas.

The County Clerk is ordered to index into the real property and deed records of Fort Bend County in a manner that describes (a), Fort Bend County abandoning the drainage easement as grantor and (b), the property owners, Jimmy Calhoun and wife, Charlotte Calhoun, receiving the conveyance as grantees.

RESOLUTION TO ABANDON 60 FOOT BY 887 FOOT DRAINAGE EASEMENT LOCATED ON PROPERTY OWNED BY JIMMY CALHOUN AND WIFE, CHARLOTTE CALHOUN, IN FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County acquired a drainage easement from Jimmy Calhoun and wife, Charlotte Calhoun on or about March 4, 1994 by donation of such drainage easement and recorded in document number 9414228 in the real property records of Fort Bend County, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the 60 foot by 887 drainage easement parcel donated March 4, 1994 is no longer needed and should be and is abandoned; and,

WHEREAS, per document number 9414228 granting said easement, the property reverts to Jimmy Calhoun and wife, Charlotte Calhoun upon non use by Fort Bend County; and

WHEREAS, that portion of drainage easement to be abandoned is no longer needed, and Fort Bend County desires to abandon;

THEREFORE, on this date the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas abandons the 60 foot by 887 foot drainage easement described herein, as shown in the easement document and exhibit attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

After due consideration, the Court finds that the above described parcel of drainage easement, originally donated to the county by Jimmy Calhoun and wife, Charlotte Calhoun, on or about March 4, 1994, is no longer required and any necessary drainage easement requirements have been redesigned to better serve the interest of the public and Fort Bend County, that such easement is no longer needed and that of the public interest would be better served if the above described drainage easement is abandoned.

IT IS ORDERED that the drainage easement described herein be abandoned and the same is hereby abandoned. That the same easement revert to its original owners, Jimmy Calhoun and wife, Charlotte Calhoun and that this Order be hereby filed in the deed records of Fort Bend County, Texas forthwith.

RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT

THE STATE OF TEXAS S COUNTY OF FORT BEND S

KNOW ALL MEN PRESENT: That the undersigned, Jimmy Calhoun and wife, Charlotte Calhoun, Rt. 1, Box 128 Rosenberg, Texas 77471-9525 whose address is as shown above (hereinafter called Grantor, whether one or more) for and in consideration of the benefits to be deprived on account of and from the construction, operation and maintenance by FORT BEND COUNTY, of the drainage canal and system upon and through the land hereinafter described, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed, has bargained, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents hereby grants, bargains, sells and conveys unto the said FORT BEND COUNTY, of Fort Bend County, Texas, a right-of-way easement for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, operating and repairing a drainage canal, upon, over, through and across the land of Grantor along the route hereinafter designated, and said land being situated in FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, to-wit:

The County shall have a 60' (sixty) foot wide right-of-way drainage easement 887 (eight hundred and eighty seven) feet in length. Said easement having it's centerline along the Southeast line of a called 1.97 Acre tract out of the B. McCauley Survey, A-558 of Fort Bend County, Texas. Said tract being described in Vol 2244 Page 1268 of the Official Public Records of Fort Bend County, Texas.

FORT BEND COUNTY shall have all rights and benefits necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use of the rights herein granted, with the right of ingress or egress to and from said drainage canal right-of-way, provided, however, that after construction of said drainage canal, said right of ingress and egress of FORT BEND COUNTY shall be limited to the said right-of-way and to existing roads and passageways. FORT BEND COUNTY is given the right from time to time to cut and remove all trees, undergrowth, and abate other obstruction, upon said canal right-of-way, that may injure, endanger, or interfere with the construction, operation, maintenance and repair of said drainage canal.

FORT BEND COUNTY agrees during the life of this easement to repair all damage to roads, passageways and fences resulting from the County's use in going to and from said easement right-of-way, and to restore the same to the previously existing condition as near as possible.

Grantor reserves the right to use the facilities offered by the drainage canal for the disposal of surface waters, rain, or any excess waters collecting upon his land, and in such connection Grantor has the right in the manner provided by law and at his own expense to construct and provide ditches, drains and laterals connecting his land or portions thereof with the drainage canal.

Grantor reserves the oil, gas, sulphur and other minerals in and under the land covered by this easement, provided however, that during the life of this easement no mining or drilling operations shall be conducted upon the surface of the area included in the
