Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office RE: Extension of 2011 Interlocal Agreement Automobile Burglary Theft Prevention Authority Fund Grant Between FBCSO and City of Houston

Dear Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office;

The City of Houston, acting through the Houston Police Department has applied for the 2013 grant from the Automobile Burglary Theft Prevention Authority (ABPTA). The grant requires the City to pay FBCSO a total of \$29,371 (\$25,337) 50% of base salary, (\$1,500) per diem and (\$2,534). FBCSO is required to contribute \$25,337 for one investigator (based on 50% of the salary hours and benefits listed in Exhibit "A").

The 2011 Agreement provided in part as follows:

- 1. The term of this Agreement is to commence on the date of receipt of a written notice to proceed from the City and terminate on the Grant expiration date, or on the termination date of any extension thereof granted by the Automobile Burglary Theft Prevention Authority, hereinafter referred to as "ABTPA", or August 31, 2012, whichever is later. In the event ABTPA Grant funding is available for the purpose of this Agreement after the expiration date the HPD Police Chief ("Chief") is authorized to extend this Agreement for one year at a time for up to four additional years.
- 2. City and FBCSO acknowledge that during the term of this Agreement the amounts provided in Exhibit "A" may change as City's application for renewal of Grant funding in the future years is reviewed by ABTPA. It is further understood and agreed that any application for additional Grant funds over and above those amounts shown in Exhibit "A", shall first be approved by City and FBCSO and will be in accordance with the effective GRANT APPLICATION AND ADMINISTRATION GUIDELINES of ABTPA. In the event this Agreement is extended the Chief is authorized to approve changes to Exhibit "A" provided the changes do not exceed the grant funds and additional funds allocated by City for the purpose of the ABTPA Grant.



Please sign below to acknowledge that the 2011 ABTPA Interlocal Agreement is extended for a Third one year term. In addition please sign Exhibit "A" as indicated to acknowledge that FBCSO will provide a FBCSO Officer Investigator as required by the ABTPA Grant.

Thank you for your continued support and participation in this important law enforcement program.

A. Fort Bend County Sheriff Investigator (1)

This Fort Bend County Sheriff Investigator will work with the members of this grant serving as a liaison between members of this unit and other local, state and federal law enforcement agencies. The Investigator will actively participate in investigations conducted by members of this grant that overlap local law enforcement's jurisdictional lines in the State of Texas. This Investigator will assist local law enforcement officers in disseminating information regarding problem vehicle titles. This investigator will also assist local law enforcement officers when stolen vehicles are recovered outside the jurisdiction of the reporting agency.

^{*}Please note: the City, through the ABTPA grant pays per diem only (\$1,500), 50% of base salary (\$25,337) and overtime \$2,534 for the Investigator. The remaining personnel expenses listed above (\$47,214) are listed for tracking of "In-Kind Match Funds" within the grant and will not be paid by the City to FBCSO.
