Meal Food Costs

I, Sergeant A. D. Lopez Badge #20 assigned to the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office Detention Kitchen, am requesting additional funds to close out the 2013 fiscal year. The Traditional Pyramid Program has been changed and the "My Plate Program" was enacted; therefore, causing our menu's to be changed. Our current menus were approved by the Dietitian at Oak Bend Hospital on April 2013. The menu changes require additional protein, grains, milk, fruits and vegetables. Due to the changes we are requesting additional funds in the amount of \$90,000.00 to get us through the month of September.

Based on the projected increase in food cost it is necessary to review the approved 2014 food budget of \$1,100.00.00. In reviewing six months of groceries purchased with the new menu changes it is expected an additional \$160,000.00 will be needed for 2014 Fiscal Year.

"Fort Bend County Jail Food Price Increase"

The United States Department of Agriculture "Choose My Plate.Gov" replaced the traditional "Food Pyramid" and Texas Commission on Jail Standards Title 37 Chapter 281 "Food Service" "Requiring meals to be served in accordance with written menu approved and reviewed annually for compliance with nationally recognized allowances for basic nutrition".
