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Project Merits and Needs: (Up to 40 Points)

Project Title:

HHW Management Collection Events

Need for Project:

Two major HHW disposal events are planned for the North and East areas of Fort Bend County for its citizens who have noted that the HHW/Recycle Center is too far for residents to travel. This event, when announced, will help the citizens process their HHW materials and educate them on the dangers of illegal dumping of HHW materials. The population to be served is around 77,000 in the north area and 38,000 in the east area of the county.

Objective:

The population needs to have access to reasonable locations to take care of their HHW materials to help protect the environment.

Project Feasibility:

The H-GAC vendor will work with the County on these events. PSC handles many of these events and works with Fort Bend County to take the HHW materials.

Outreach and Education:

Fort Bend County and its HHW/Recycling staff will coordinate activities to make presentations to various organizations and update its website accordingly. County staff will also be contacting the cities and working with various education channels to get the publicity out to the citizens.

Innovation:

County works with these entities for the benefit of the citizens and for protecting the environment.
