- WHEREAS, about 1 million volunteers work with Habitat for Humanity every year worldwide, and over 2,000 Fort Bend citizens each year donate over 30,000 hours of volunteer time toward building homes for their fellow citizens in Fort Bend County; and
- WHEREAS, during World Habitat Month this October, Fort Bend Habitat for Humanity joins the United Nations and organizations around the world in raising awareness, education and mobilizing individuals and communities to take action on the current housing crisis.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert E. Hebert, County Judge of Fort Bend County, do hereby proclaim October, 2013 as

"WORLD HABITAT MONTH IN FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS"

and encourage all citizens to celebrate the significance and impact on our community.
