FBCMUD No. 25 Fence Relocation Red Gulley Easement Notes

Fort Bend County MUD No. 25 dedicated the ultimate right-of-way of 120' north of the Red Gulley centerline within a drainage easement recorded under "Fort Bend County Public Record Instrument No.2009105211" and a plat titled "Fort Bend County MUD No. 25 North District Site", approved by the Drainage District on July 3, 2012.

In October 2013 FBCMUD No. 25 requested the right to clear vegetation within the 120' ultimate right-of-way, install a backslope drainage swale along the north limits of the easement, install an interceptor structure that would drain back to the north into their polishing pond, and relocate their fence approximately 35' to the south into the ultimate easement of Red Gulley in order to better maintain their polishing pond.

The existing northern top bank of Red Gulley was located approximately 30' from the centerline. Shifting the fence to the south 35' did not interfere with the existing location of the channel or the adjacent 30' maintenance berm.

The Drainage District agreed to allow the proposed work by FBCMUD No. 25 with the understanding that the fence would be relocated off of the 120' ultimate easement when future channel expansion of Red Gulley occured. The FBCMUD No. 25 engineer provided assurance that the MUD was acceptable to this condition as documented in the attached letter, dated October 16, 2013.

Construction plans showing the proposed work are attached. The contractor was instructed to obtain a permit from the Fort Bend County Permit Administrator prior to any work with the FBCDD right-of-way.

The FBCMUD No. 25 engineer at the time of approval was Sherrington, Inc., (281) 758-1531 and the contractor performing the work was Steve Redd with Reddico Construction, (281) 491-9915.




MAINTENANCE BERM FOR POLISHING POND AT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT No. 2


