Section 4: Carl Mazzo is hereby re-appointed as a director on the Board of Directors for First Colony Levee Improvement District No. 2 of Fort Bend County, Texas, to serve in that capacity for a two year term of office expiring on January 5, 2016 or until his successor shall be appointed and qualified.
