Conventional Roads

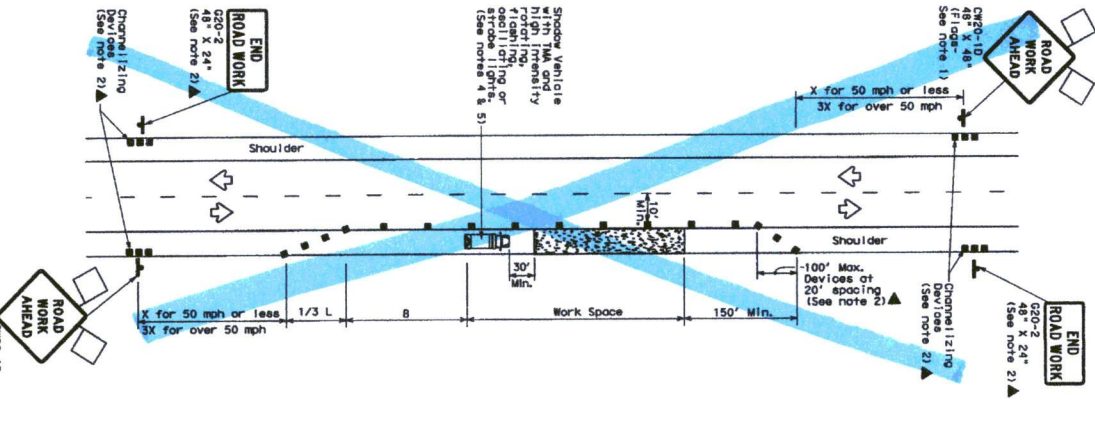
TCP (1-1a)

Conventional Roads

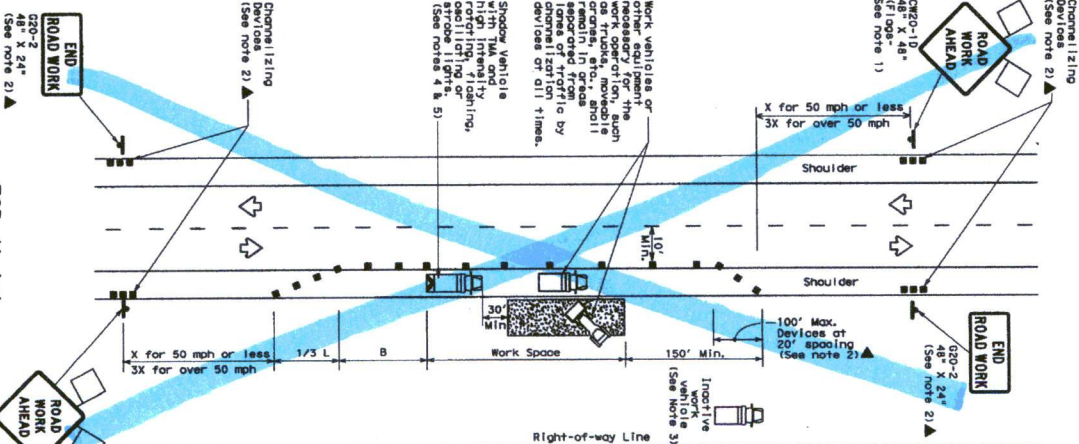
TCP (1-1b)

GENERAL NOTES

1. Flare attached to signs where shown are required.
2. Signs with the triangle symbol may be omitted when erected elsewhere in the plan, or for routine maintenance work, when approved by the Engineer.
3. Inactive work vehicles or other equipment should be parked near the right-of-way line and not ported on the paved shoulder.
4. A Shadow Vehicle with a TMA should be used anytime it can be positioned 30 to 100 feet in advance of the crew of work vehicles without adversely affecting the performance or quality of the work. The Shadow Vehicle should remain in place. Type 3 Barricades or other channelizing devices may be substituted for the Shadow Vehicle and TMA.
5. Additional Shadow Vehicles with TMA may be positioned off the paved shoulder to protect the work area from errant vehicles.
6. See TCP 15-11 for shoulder work on divided highways, expressways and freeways.
7. C81-5 "SHOULDER WORK" signs may be used in place of G20-10 "ROAD WORK AHEAD" signs for shoulder work on conventional roadways.

For construction or maintenance contract work, specific details and instructions for sign placement can be found in the project GENERAL NOTES for Item 502, Barricades, Signs and Traffic Handling.
