RESOLUTION DESIGNATING BRIDGE ON KATY-FLEWELLEN ROAD

Whereas, Jacque Endresen, a 17 year old Cinco Ranch High School Student, lost her life on Katy-Flewellen Road in a traffic accident adjacent to the old bridge that stood there on July 17, 2006; and

Whereas, the nature of the motor vehicle collision that claimed her life served as an additional catalyst for Fort Bend County to seek bond authority for improvements greatly expanding the capacity of Katy-Flewellen and constructing the bridge we are naming today ; and

Whereas, motivated in part by Jacque's tragic death, Fort Bend voters overwhelmingly approved the bonds necessary for construction; and

Whereas, Jacque was a beloved friend to many and the community was made brighter by her smile, her kindness, and her gentle disposition; and

Whereas, we long to honor her life and her passing in the hope that all those who pass this bridge will honor Jacque's memory as they travel in greater comfort and safety over the now improved Katy-Flewellen Road.

Therefore, be it known that Fort Bend County Commissioners Court designates the bridge on Katy-Flewellen Road at the Willow Fork of the Buffalo Bayou is hereby named the


Jacque Endresen Bridge


and authorizes appropriate signage constructed to county standards to be erected and maintained on each side of the bridge in honor of this promising young lady who was lost far too soon.
