EXITING ELECTED OFFICIAL EXPENDITURE ORDER PER SECTION 130.908 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE 2014 CALENDAR YEAR

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code Section 130.908 requires Commissioners Court to approve any expenditure of an elected county or precinct officer who was not renominated or reelected that is over an amount set by the Commissioners Court; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Order is to establish expenditure limits that require Commissioners Court approval.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. When a Fort Bend County Elected Official is not renominated or reelected, during the time following the date of the announcement of the results of the official canvass of the primary or election returns, expenditures that exceed \$5,000 shall require advance approval by Commissioners Court before the County is obligated to pay the expenditure.
- 2. This order shall be applicable to all expenditures by the Exiting Elected Official, except those expenditures made exclusively from funds that by statute are not under the control of Commissioners Court.
- 3. This Exiting Elected Official Expenditure Order shall not be applicable to any personnel and/or salary matters, which shall remain subject to established County policies.
- 4. This Exiting Elected Official Expenditure Order is effective as of the date signed.
