**RESOLUTION RENAMING GORDON RANCH TO JONES CREEK
RANCH PARK**

WHEREAS, Gordon Ranch is a certain real property recently purchased by Fort Bend County (hereinafter "the County") located in Fort Bend County, Texas, containing approximately 112.617 acres designated solely for use as a public facility for park land and other recreational purposes, as more particularly described in **Exhibit A** attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes, hereinafter "the Property"; and

WHEREAS, the Property has heretofore been known as Gordon Ranch; and

WHEREAS, the Property is no longer being used as a Ranch, but has since been designated as a County Park intended to be for the use and pleasure of visitors to the Park; and,

WHEREAS, the County now wishes to re-designate the name of Gordon Ranch to Jones Creek Ranch Park;


THEREFORE, be it known that Fort Bend County Commissioners Court designates the property formerly known as Gordon Ranch to be hereby renamed

JONES CREEK RANCH PARK

and authorizes appropriate signage constructed to county standards to be erected and maintained on the Property where necessary, as determined at a later date.

IT IS ORDERED to rename the Property as listed herein as Exhibit "A" as the Jones Creek Ranch Park to be effective October 14, 2014.

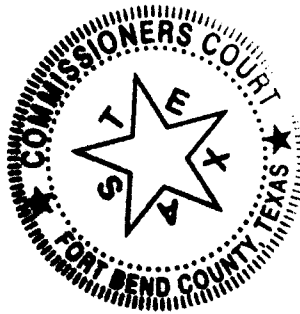

EXHIBIT "A"

DEED

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All that certain tract or parcel of land bring in the John Foster 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ League Grant, Abstract 26, Fort Bend County, Texas.

Being at an iron pipe found marking the Northeast corner of a 37.358 acre tract and marking the Southeast corner of a call Tract III, 35.34 acres (Vol. 346, page 270; Deed Records; said point being the Southeast corner for this Tract;

THENCE, North 65° 34' West, pass Steel tower power line, in all along a fence line, 1596 feet to an iron pipe for corner;

THENCE, South 89° 23' 20" West, along a fence line, at 50 feet pass power line, at 149.95 feet pass centerline of Jones Creek (Brazos Valley Irrigation Right-of-way, July 7, 1929); at 957.08 feet pass iron pipe found, in all 960.38 feet to a corner post for corner;

THENCE, South 0° 2' 10" West, along a wood fence, 158.6 feet to an iron pipe found for corner;

THENCE, Northwesterly along the East line of State Farm Market Road #359 (100 feet wide), with the following courses and distances:
North 31° 54' West, 488.92 feet to a point;
North 29° 48' 32" West, 198.28 feet to a point;
North 26° 40' 10" West, 197.45 feet to a point;
North 24° 14' 30" West, 210.19 feet to a concrete monument found;
North 22° 0' 40" West, 337.83 feet to a corner post marking the West corner of this Tract;

THENCE, North 67° 27' East, along a fence line 709.87 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE, North 0° 11' 40" East, along a fence line 1365.77 feet to a corner post marking the Northwest corner of this Tract;

THENCE, North 89° 54' 50" East, along a fence line, 1207.65 feet to an iron pipe found marking the Northeast corner of this Tract;

THENCE, South 3° 25' East, along a fence line, 2258.76 feet to a point in the centerline of said Jones Creek;

THENCE, Southeasterly along the centerline of said Jones Creek with the following courses and distances:
South 80° 46' 10" East, 155.18 feet to a point;
South 74° 11' 40" East, 351.88 feet to a point;
South 61° 57' 40" East, 93.75 feet to a point;
South 66° 2' 15" East, 541.63 feet to a point marking the Northeast corner of this Tract;

THENCE, South along a fence line, 760 feet to the place of beginning, containing 112.617 acres of land.
