## THE AGREEMENT IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

In accordance with Item 2. Term of Agreement of the Operations Agreement, the Parties agree to extend the term of the Operations Agreement to September 30, 2019.

In accordance with Item 5. Hours of Operation of the Operations Agreement, the University requests extended operational hours, beginning on January 2, 2015, and continuing through September 30, 2019. Extended hours will be from 10:00 a.m. until 12 p.m. on Mondays, from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on Wednesdays, and from 10:00 a.m. until 12 p.m. on Fridays, for a total of seven additional operational hours per week. The County agrees to an extended hours total annual cost of \$31,378, prorated to \$23,534 for the period of January 2, 2015 through September 30, 2015. Starting October 1, 2015, the University and the County agree that the annual cost for the extended hours can increase up to a maximum of 6% per year, based on documentation provided by the County. The University and the County both reserve the right to terminate extended hours with ninety (90) days' notice.

Item 10. Payment for Library Services shall be modified as follows:

UHS shall fund the County \$40,000 for higher educational library materials in fiscal year 2015, \$45,000 in fiscal year 2016, and \$50,000 in fiscal year 2017. The annual funding for higher educational library materials provided to the county shall remain at \$50,000 in fiscal year 2018 and in fiscal year 2019. The University will have the option to fund up to an additional \$5,000 per year in fiscal year 2018 and fiscal year 2019 for purchase of select materials designated by the University, if needed by University programs.

In addition, for fiscal year 2015, the University will pay the County \$124,942 for the Academic Liaison and the Academic Liaison Assistant salaries and benefits. The university agrees to fund a maximum increase of 6% each year from fiscal year 2016 through fiscal year 2019 to be used for merit, cost of living adjustments, or reclassifications for the academic librarians and staff as needed, based on documentation provided by the county and availability of funding.

To the extent the terms, provisions, covenants, or conditions in this Amendment are inconsistent with those in the Agreement, the terms, provisions, covenants, or conditions in this Amendment shall control and be binding on the Parties upon full execution of this Amendment by the Parties authorized representatives. All other terms, provisions, covenants, and conditions in the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be superseded by this Amendment. This Amendment, together with the Agreement, constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof.
