## SECOND RENEWAL OF AGREEMENT FOR AUTOPSIES AND RELATED SERVICES BETWEEN FORT BEND COUNTY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS MEDICAL BRANCH AT GALVESTON

This Second Renewal of Interlocal Agreement for UTMB Forensic Pathology Services ("Second Renewal") is made and entered into by and between **The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston**, an institution of The University of Texas System, which is an agency of the State of Texas, for and on behalf of its Department of Pathology ("UTMB"), and **Fort Bend County**, **Texas** ("County"), effective September 1, 2014, regardless of the date of execution.

## **RECITALS**

- A. UTMB and County (the "parties") entered into that certain Agreement for Autopsies and Related Services (the "Agreement") effective September 1, 2013, wherein UTMB agreed to provide certain medical examiner services to County as more specifically described in the Agreement.
- B. The parties executed that certain First Renewal of Interlocal Agreement for UTMB Forensic Pathology Services ("First Renewal") effective March 1, 2014, to extend the term and amend the Agreement as provided therein.
- C. The parties now wish to enter into this Second Renewal of Interlocal Agreement ("Second Renewal") to extend the term an additional three (3) months with an automatic renewal upon completion of the said three-month extension on a month-to-month basis throughout the remainder of the UTMB Fiscal year 2014-2015, and to amend the Agreement as provided herein.

## **AGREEMENT**

For and in consideration of the terms and conditions set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereby agree to renew the Agreement as follows:

1. Extension of Agreement Term. The term of the Agreement is extended for an additional three (3) months with an automatic renewal upon completion of the said three-month extension on a month-to-month basis throughout the remainder of the UTMB Fiscal year 2014-2015, which such Fiscal Year ends on August 31, 2015, unless terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of the Parties. UTMB and County agree that execution of this Second Renewal by both parties is effective to extend the term of the Agreement, as previously amended, and any other conditions for extension or renewal contained in the Agreement are hereby waived for the purpose of effecting this renewal term. Any additional extensions of the term shall be governed by the provisions of the Agreement.

The Parties further agree and acknowledge that this Agreement, including all amendments hereto, continues solely on a month-to-month basis after November 30, 2014 and thus may be terminated by either Party hereto providing at least one-month prior written notice of its intent to terminate this Agreement, including all amendments hereto, to the other Party.

2. <u>Continuation of Service Rates</u>. During the extended term of the Agreement set forth in paragraph 1 of this Second Renewal, including the month-to-month extension period effective after November 30, 2014, the Fees and Payment for autopsies and external view autopsies set forth in Paragraph 2.1 of the Agreement shall remain in effect.

3. Ratification and Defined Terms. Except as amended or modified by this Second Renewal, the Agreement shall continue in full force and effect. UTMB and County each hereby ratify, affirm, and agree that the Agreement, as herein modified, represents the valid, binding, and enforceable obligations of UTMB and County, respectively. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the provisions of the Agreement and the First Renewal, the provisions of this Second Renewal shall control and govern. Except as otherwise defined in this Second Renewal, each of the terms used herein shall have the same meaning assigned to such terms in the Agreement.
