

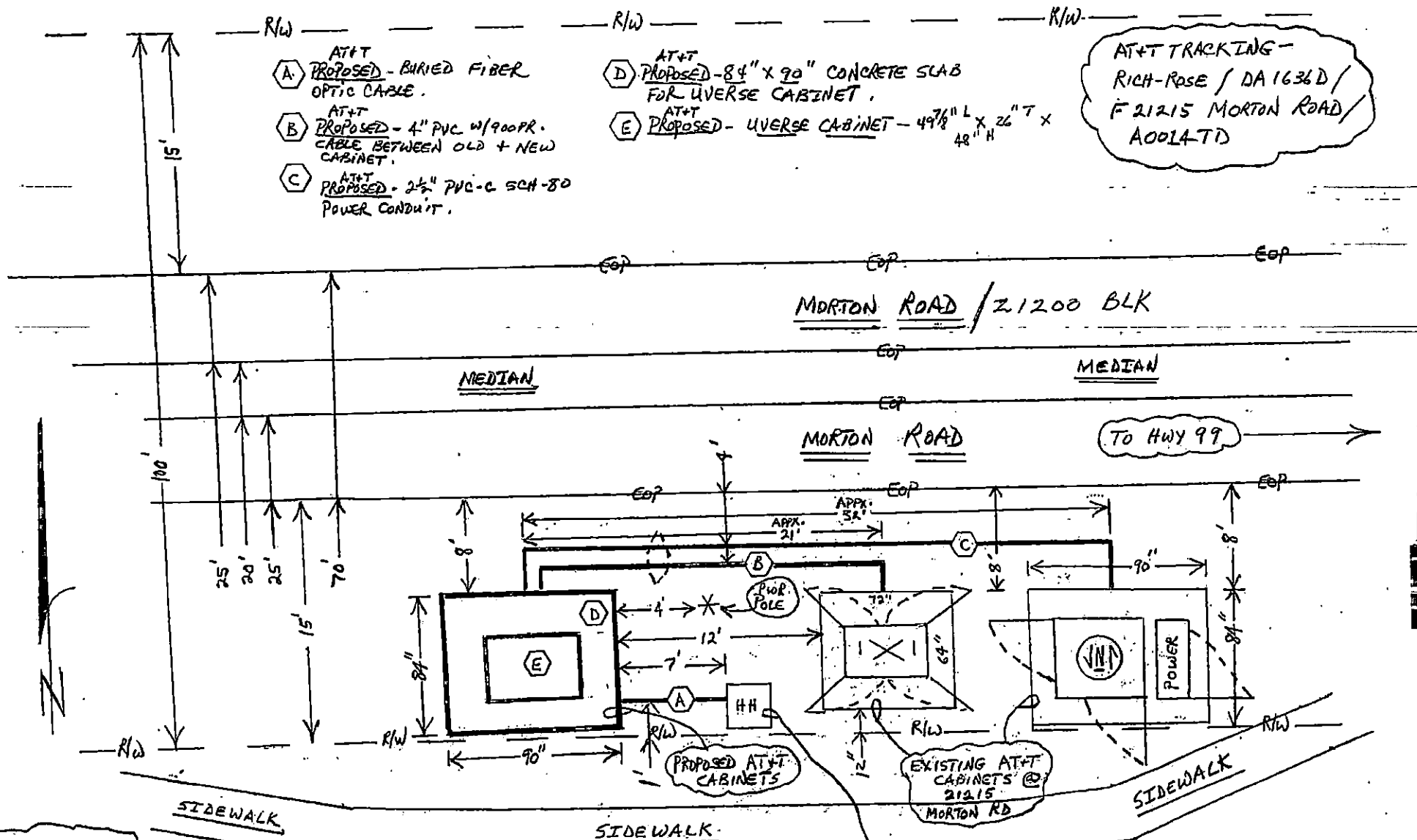

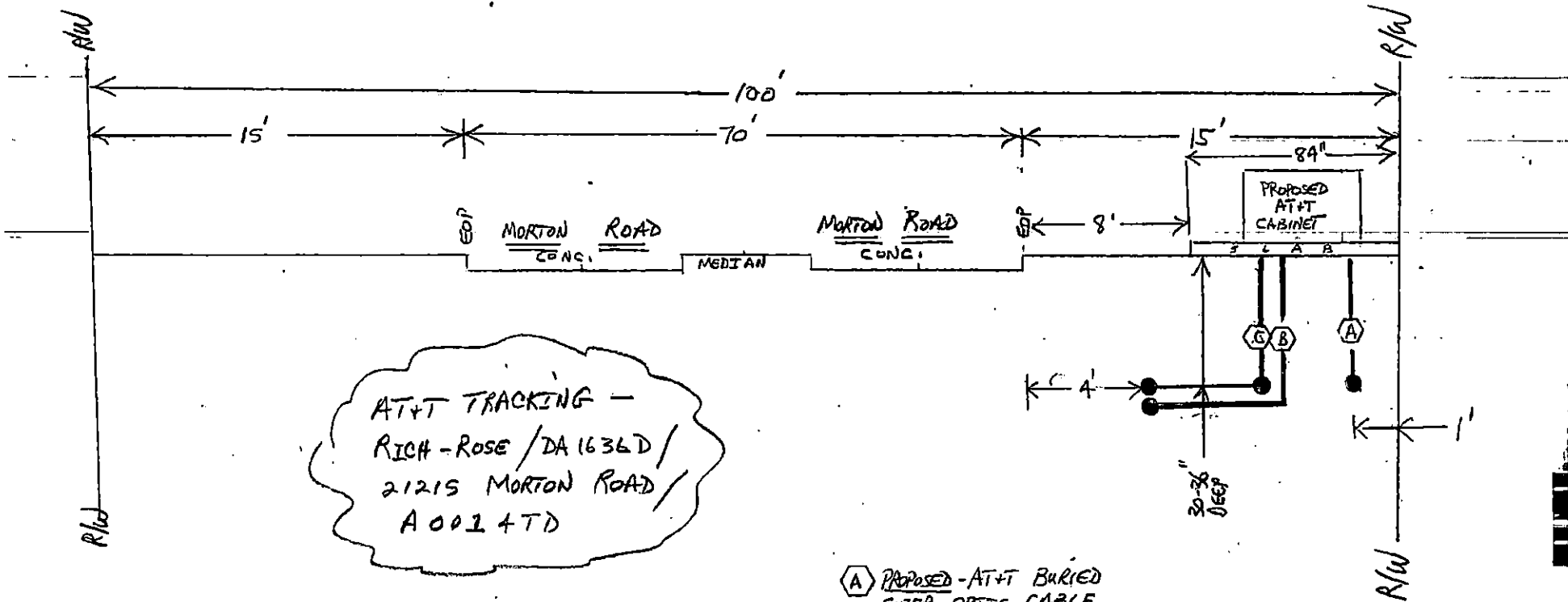
EXISTING AT&T FIBER OPTIC HAND HOLE
