hereby referred to and made a part hereof for all purposes as though fully set out herein;

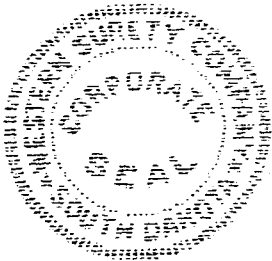
AND WHEREAS, the principal desires to provide Fort Bend County with a performance

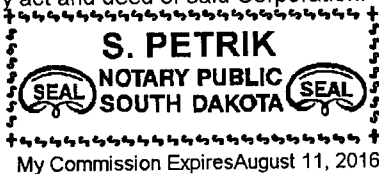

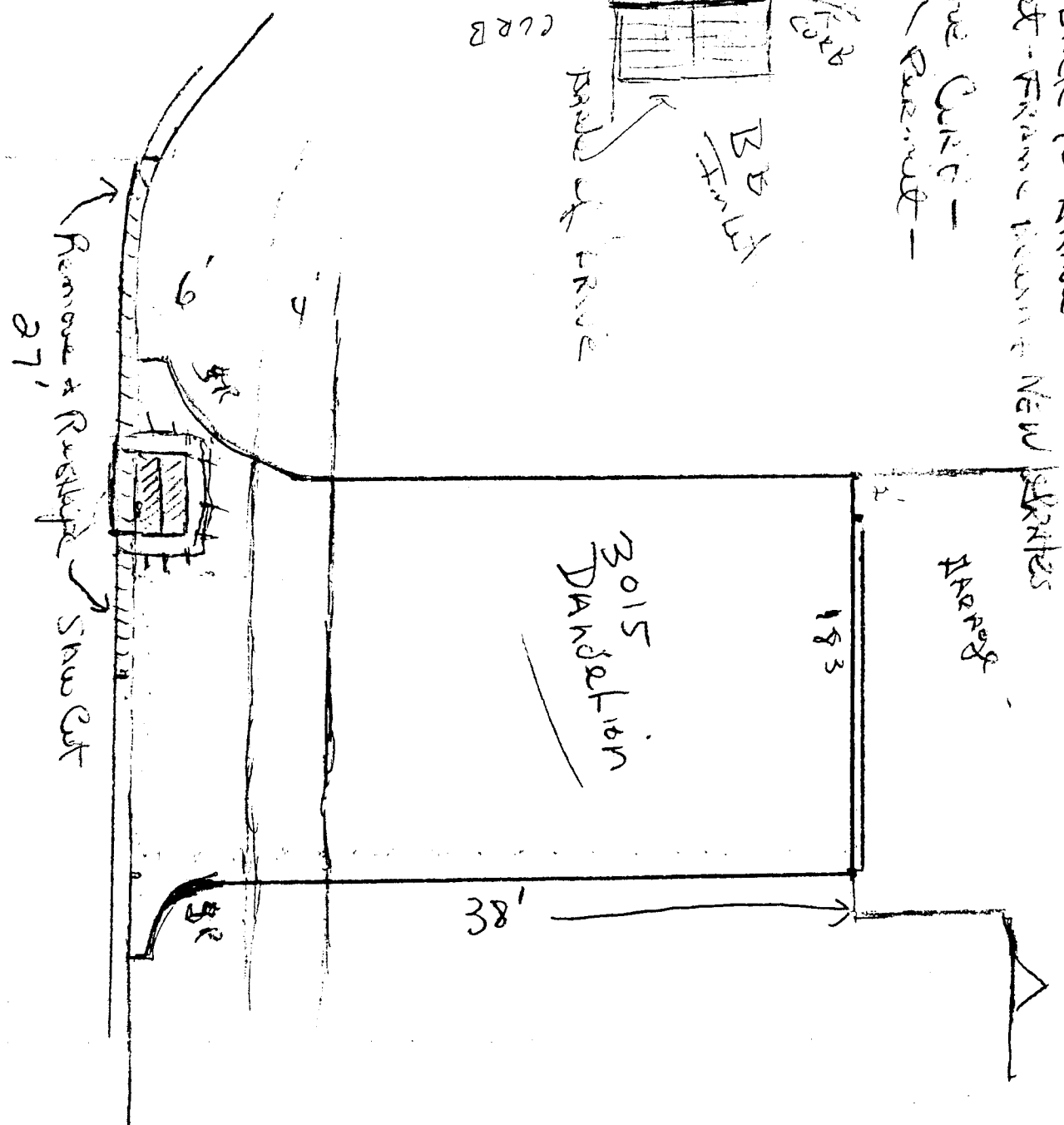
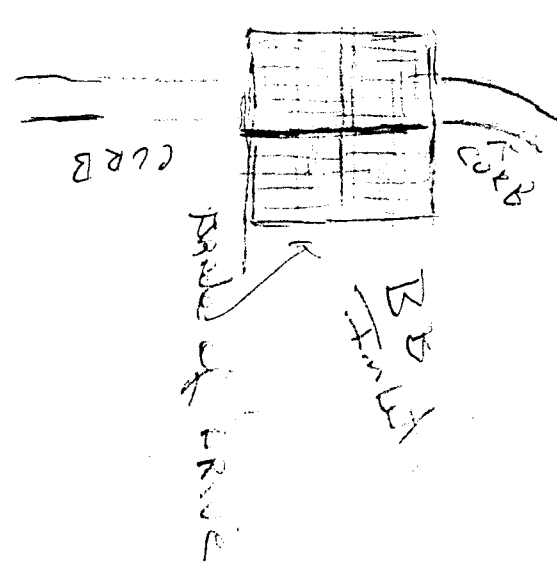
