

RESOLUTION OF COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY

**REQUESTING THE STATE LEGISLATURE TO CREATE
AN ADDITIONAL COUNTY COURT AT LAW**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas has found that public need and necessity requires that an additional County Court at Law be created for Fort Bend County by the 84th Legislature sitting in Austin, Travis County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, has found that the best interest of the County would best be served by establishing a new County Court at Law with general jurisdiction the same as County Courts at Law No. 1, No. 2, No. 3 and No. 4 having the effective date of presentment and approval of the Governor; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas does hereby request that the 84th Legislature declare an emergency and create County Court at Law No. 5 of Fort Bend County in the 84th Legislature, and the said County Court at Law with general jurisdiction be established to conduct business after presentment and approval of the Governor with the initial vacancy being filled by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas.
