# Sanders optimistic for basketball for Tompkins Falcons

In its first year at the varsity level, Tompkins Head Boys Basketball Coach Bobby Sanders is quite optimistic for the season ahead.

"Things are looking pretty promising right now," Sanders said. "I'm excited about the future."

Last year, the basketball program competed at the sophomore level and went undefeated and won the district title at that level. With that kind of talent on board, Sanders believes his Falcons might be ready to make some noise this season in District 19-6A.

"I think we can really compete," Sanders said. "We have some guys that can play. We have some size and we have some good guards and some guys who are some pretty good players."

Sophomore Josh Williams is the point guard for the Falcons and Sanders believes his season ahead could be a very strong one. Williams stands at 6-0.

"He is a strong player and one of our better shooters as well," Sanders said.

Alex Tchouangwa plays the wing for the Falcons and is a returning player as well.

"He is very athletic and will play the wing for us," Sanders said. The team is also bolstered by newcomers to the program this year including a 6-6 center Aziz Fadika, who attended Cinco Ranch last year but lives in the Tompkins attendance zone.

Sanders is also looking for big things out of freshmen C.J. Washington and Jamal Bientemy.

Washington is a 6-3 forward and Bientemy is a 6-3 guard.

"While we may have some size, what we don't have is experience," Sanders said. "I am thinking that by January we might look like an actual varsity team."

Sanders is hoping that a tough non-district schedule will get his team ready and primed for the wars of District 19-6A.

"We have a pretty tough schedule coming up," Sanders said. "We will see early if they can get used to the speed of a varsity game. Once they get used to that, I think they will adjust with our talent."

Sanders has been at the helm of the Tompkins bas-

kettball program for two years and previously served at Morton Ranch as an assistant and before that as head coach for Episcopal High School in Belaire for 12 years.

In this first year, Sanders said it will be important that his coaching staff help keep the players on an even keel as the season begins. He knows that the team will take its share of early season lumps but he also knows that the talent on this team could come through come district season as well.

"The challenges will be getting them not to think about the results on the scoreboard as quickly but think about getting better at all the little things," Sanders said. "All they want to do is think about the scoreboard but that will take care of itself if we do all the little things right."

"The challenge for these guys will be to see the big picture for us," Sanders said.

Sanders will take his team of juniors, sophomores and freshmen into a talented District 19-6A with the likes of Seven Lakes, Cinco Ranch, Katy and Strake Jesuit among the talented teams in this district. He knows the challenge will be tough.

"Seven Lakes is the favorite because they were the best last year and they still have the best player in the district on their team," Sanders said. "I don't see why they wouldn't be the favorite and Cinco Ranch was a good team last year and they have some guys back on their team. I know that Morton Ranch has a lot of upper classmen coming back this year and Katy and Strake Jesuit are always competitive."

"It will be a struggle just to get into the top four in this district," Sanders said. "Just to be in the hunt for a playoff berth is our goal this year. That would be pretty exciting for us this first year."

"The same three of four teams are always at the top of this district every year so it will be hard for a young team to compete in this district," Sanders said. "To try to break into that top four will be very tough."

Sanders said the key to this upcoming season for Tompkins will be how quickly his young team gets used to the varsity level of play.

"If they can do that, then we will be successful," Sanders said. "We are making our practices as intense as the games that we will be playing in. We don't want the game to shock anybody."
