**MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
ENSTOR KATY STORAGE AND TRANSPORTATION, L.P. ("ENSTOR KATY")
AND
FORT BEND COUNTY**

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is between Enstor Katy Storage and Transportation, L.P., principal office located at 20329 State Highway 249, Suite 500, Houston, TX 77070 ("Enstor Katy") and Fort Bend County by and through the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office ("FBCSO"), 1410 Williams Way Blvd., Richmond, TX 77469. Enstor Katy and WFD are sometimes referred to herein individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

I. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this MOU is to establish a mutual understanding for the provision of emergency response services for the Enstor Katy facility, physically located at 25959 Westheimer Parkway, Katy, TX 77494 ("Enstor Katy Facility"). Enstor Katy is designated as a high risk chemical facility for the Chemical of Interest (methane) at the facility under the US Department of Homeland Security, Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards (CFATS), 6 C.F.R. Part 27.

Both parties have a mutual interest and responsibility for the planning, preparedness and response to minimize consequences of an emergency at the facility thereby protecting people, property and the environment. Should an incident occur at the Enstor Katy Facility, both Parties should cooperate in coordinating efforts to secure any incident areas, personnel, equipment, and public roadways. FBCSO shall respond to all requests for service at the Enstor Katy Facility without delay.

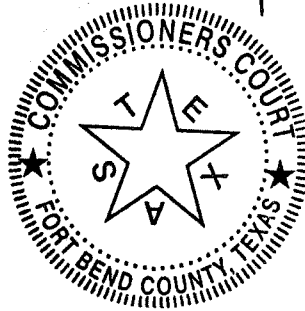
