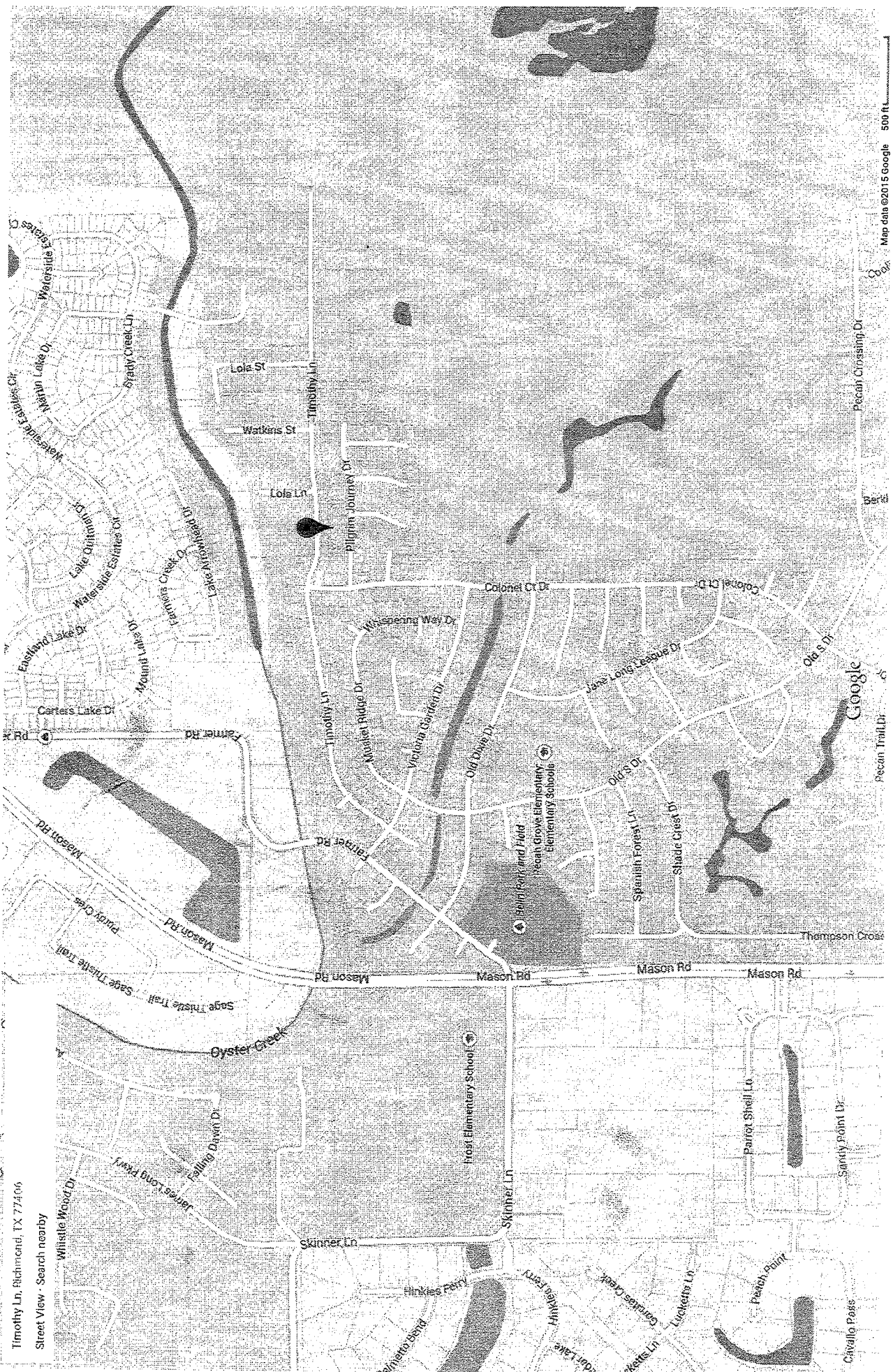


TYPICAL ONE LANE CLOSURE PLAN

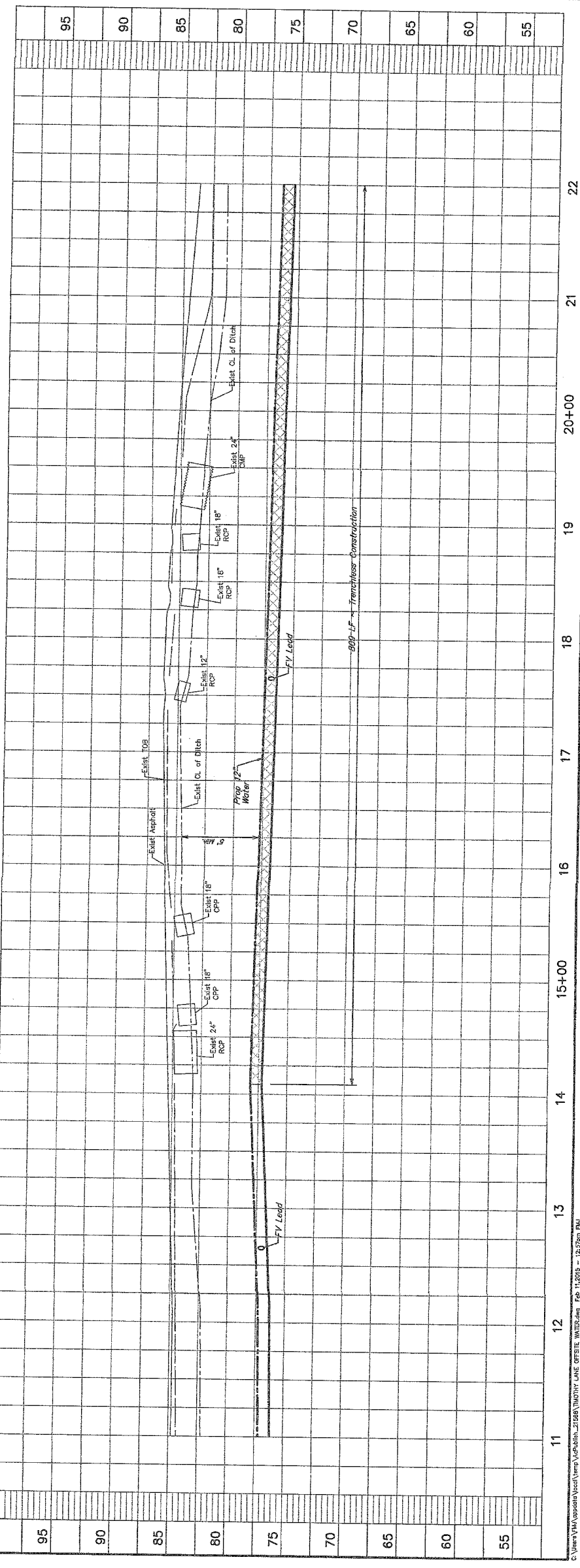
