

**ORDER APPOINTING RAMON L RAMIREZ CONSTABLE
IN FORT BEND COUNTY PRECINCT ONE**

On this day there came to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, the matter of an appointment to fill a vacancy in the office of Constable Precinct One, Fort Bend County, Texas.

WHEREAS, the death of the Arthur "A.J." Dorr has created a vacancy in the office of Constable Precinct One;

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code §87.041 states the Commissioners Court may fill a vacancy in the office of Constable until the next general election;

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code §87.041 requires the Commissioners Court to fill a vacancy by a majority vote of the members of the court who are present and voting; and

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code §86.02 requires each Constable to subscribe to the official oath of office and to secure an official bond of not more than \$1,500.00 payable to the governor of the State of Texas and the governor's successors in office to secure the performance of their duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, Fort Bend County Commissioners Court through a majority vote hereby appoints Ramon L. Ramirez to serve as Constable, Precinct One, effective upon subscribing to the official oath of office and delivery of a bond payable to Greg Abbott, Governor of the State of Texas, or his successors in office securing faithful performance of his duties to fulfill the vacancy of Arthur "A.J." Dorr until the next general election.
