

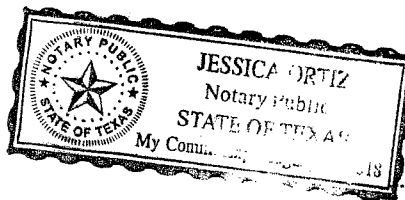
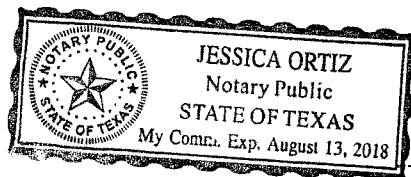

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ESTABLISHING
FORT BEND COUNTY GAME ROOM REGULATIONS**

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, will conduct a hearing on Tuesday, September 1, 2015 at 1 p.m. in Commissioners Courtroom, 401 Jackson St., 2nd Floor, Richmond, Texas, on the proposed FORT BEND COUNTY GAME ROOM REGULATIONS.

The Regulations conform with Chapter 234 of the Texas Local Government Code, as amended by SB 1210, 84th Legislature, Regular Session, which states that the commissioners court of a county with a population of 550,000 or more and is adjacent to a county that has a population of four million or more; by order may regulate the operation of Game Rooms to promote the public health, safety, and welfare, according to Section 231.133 of the Texas Local Government Code.
