Commissioner Morrison informed the court Lamar Consolidated will discuss their action on the reappraisal of property damaged in recent flooding at their meeting on July 12.

Judge Hebert clarified this is voluntary for each entity and each entity must act independently of the other. If Lamar Consolidated does not participate, the entire value of January 1 is applied for this tax year.

Commissioner Patterson stated CAD could be carrying two different tax appraisals at the same time.

Judge Hebert agreed, because under the law, the June 1 assessed value would be used to prorate against the January 1 value to give the reduced value for those governing agencies that request participation in the program. If they don't request to participate in the program, they will tax the properties on the January 1 values. If Lamar votes to participate, it will be a significant savings for those whose homes were damaged and will lower the County's costs because there is only one fee for the reappraisal in which a portion of the cost will be paid by Lamar Consolidated.
