(the "Order"). Such Order was duly introduced for the consideration of the Commissioners Court and reviewed in full. It was then duly moved and seconded that the Order be passed; and, after due discussion, the motion, carrying with it the passage of the Order, prevailed and carried by the following vote:

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 7th day of October, 1985, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, acting under the authority of Article XVI, Section 59 of the Texas Constitution, as amended, and Title 4, Chapter 57 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, created First Colony Levee Improvement District No. 2 of Fort Bend County, Texas (the "District"); and

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 7th day of October, 1985, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, acting under the authority of Article XVI, Section 59 of the Texas Constitution, as amended, and Title 4, Chapter 57 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, appointed George L. Houghton, Jr., Harold Dodd, and Thomas E. Moody as directors of the District; and

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 13th day of November, 1989, the Commissioners Court appointed Lawrence P. Mosher to replace George L. Houghton, Jr. for a four-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 3rd day of February, 1992, the Commissioners Court appointed Ronald J. Frerich to replace Lawrence P. Mosher for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 8th day of January, 1990, the Commissioners Court appointed Michael L. Homeyer to replace Thomas E. Moody for a two-year term, and by Order dated the 6th day of January, 1992, the Commissioners Court re-appointed Michael L. Homeyer for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 3rd day of June, 1991, the Commissioners Court appointed Ralph R. DeMarco to replace Harold Dodd for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 3rd day of January, 1994, the Commissioners Court re-appointed Michael L. Homeyer, Ronald J. Frerich, and Ralph R. DeMarco as directors of the District, each for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 12th day of December, 1995, the Commissioners Court re-appointed Michael L. Homeyer, Ronald J. Frerich, and Ralph R. DeMarco as directors of the District, each for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 6th day of January, 1998, the Commissioners Court re-appointed Michael L. Homeyer, Ronald J. Frerich, and Ralph R. DeMarco as directors of the District, each for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 26th day of January, 1999, the Commissioners Court appointed Christine M. Lukin to replace Ralph R. DeMarco for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1999, the Commissioners Court re-appointed Michael L. Homeyer, Ronald J. Frerich, and Christine M. Lukin as directors of the District, each for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 18th day of December, 2001, the Commissioners Court re-appointed Michael L. Homeyer, Ronald J. Frerich, and Christine M. Lukin as directors of the District, each for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 16th day of December, 2003, the Commissioners Court re-appointed Michael L. Homeyer, Ronald J. Frerich, and Christine M. Lukin as directors of the District, each for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December, 2005, the Commissioners Court re-appointed Michael L. Homeyer, Ronald J. Frerich, and Christine M. Lukin as directors of the District, each for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of December 2006, the Commissioners Court appointed Carl Mazzo to replace Michael L. Homeyer for a one-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2007, the Commissioners Court re-appointed Ronald J. Frerich, Christine M. Lukin, and Carl Mazzo as Directors of the District, each for a two-year term;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2009 the Commissioners Court re-appointed Ronald J. Frerich, Christine M. Lukin, and Carl Mazzo as Directors of the District, each for a two-year term expiring on January 3, 2012;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2011 the Commissioners Court re-appointed Ronald J. Frerich, Christine M. Lukin, and Carl Mazzo as Directors of the District, each for a two-year term expiring on January 7, 2014;

WHEREAS, by Order duly adopted by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December, 2013 the Commissioners Court re-appointed Ronald J. Frerich, Christine M. Lukin, and Carl Mazzo as Directors of the District, each for a two-year term expiring on January 5, 2016;

WHEREAS, the official bonds and oaths of office of Ronald J. Frerich, Christine M. Lukin, and Zach Weimer were presented to the Commissioners Court at the time of each directors appointment and were found to be in proper form and properly executed and were entered in the records of the County Clerk and are currently retained in the County Clerk's files;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, that:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals be and the same are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2: Ronald J. Frerich is hereby re-appointed as a director on the Board of Directors for First Colony Levee Improvement District No. 2 of Fort Bend County, Texas, to serve in that capacity for a four-year term of office beginning on Tuesday, January 5, 2016 and expiring on Tuesday, January 7, 2020, or until his successor shall be appointed and qualified.


Section 3: Christine M. Lukin is hereby re-appointed as a director on the Board of Directors for First Colony Levee Improvement District No. 2 of Fort Bend County, Texas, to serve in that capacity for a four-year term of office beginning on Tuesday, January 5, 2016 and expiring on Tuesday, January 7, 2020, or until her successor shall be appointed and qualified.

Section 4: Zach Weimer is hereby appointed as a director on the Board of Directors for First Colony Levee Improvement District No. 2 of Fort Bend County, Texas, to serve in that capacity for a four-year term of office beginning on Tuesday, January 5, 2016 and expiring on Tuesday, January 7, 2020, or until his successor shall be appointed and qualified.


Section 5: The County Judge is authorized to execute and the County Clerk to attest this Order on behalf of the Court.

Section 6: A copy of this Order shall be recorded in the minutes of this Court.

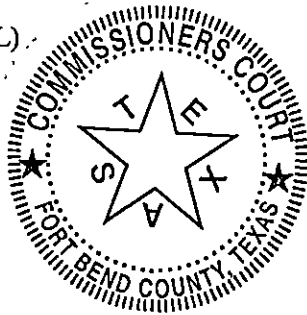
