

FT. BEND COUNTY SPECIFICATIONS

- NO MORE TRENCH OPENED AT ONE TIME THAN 100' BACKFILLED AND COMPACTED IN 24 HOURS. ALL TRENCHES TO BE OPEN OVERNIGHT.
- ALL EXCESS EXCAVATION TO BE REMOVED FROM ROAD RIGHT OF WAY AT THE END OF DAY.
- DITCHES TO BE DRENED AT END OF EACH DAY TO ASSURE ADEQUATE DRAINAGE.
- ROAD MUST BE KEPT OPEN TO TRAFFIC AND CONTRACTOR MUST PROVIDE ADEQUATE FLAGMEN, SIGNS, SIGNALS, ETC. TO PROVIDE COMPLETE SAFETY TO THE PUBLIC.
- IF IT BECOMES NECESSARY FOR EQUIPMENT TO OPERATE ON A PORTION OF THE PAVEMENT, PRECAUTIONS SHOULD BE TAKEN TO PREVENT ANY DAMAGE WHATSOEVER TO THE PAVEMENT.

- CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND INSTALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES IN CONFORMANCE WITH PART VI OF TEXAS MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, THIRD- LATEST EDITION WITH REVISIONS, DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- NO LANES SHALL BE BLOCKED DURING CONSTRUCTION.

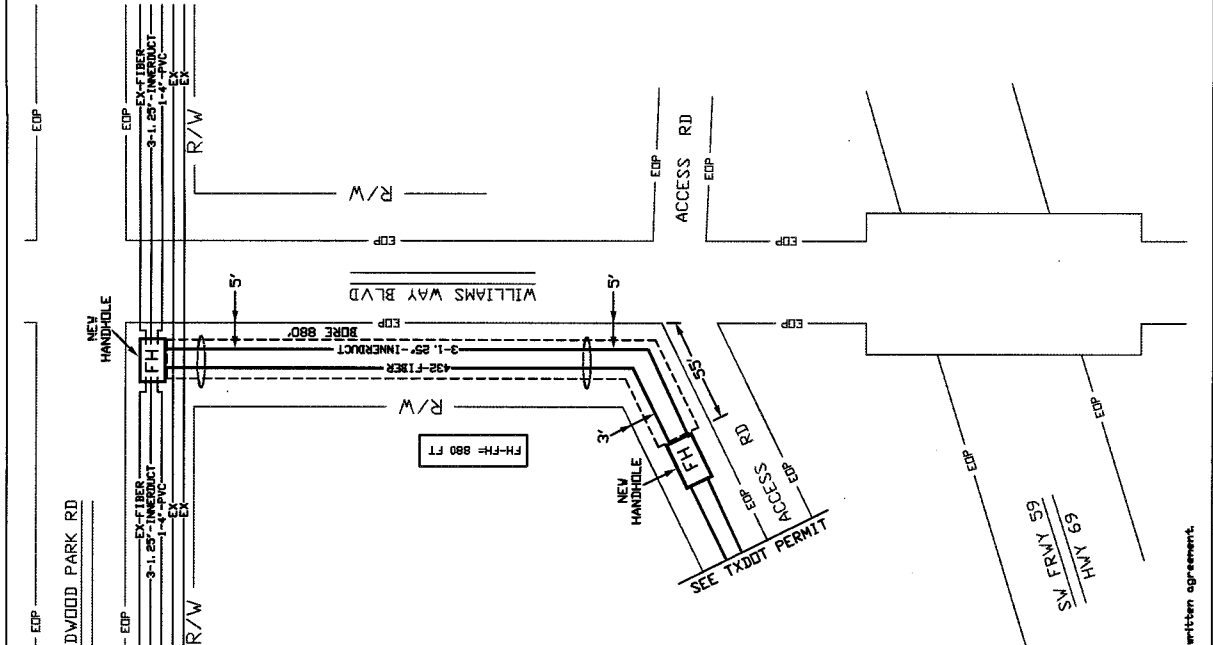
