

RESOLUTION OF COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY

APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF DORIS ROAD
FROM US 59 TO WEST TAVENER AT PINK TAYLOR RUN ROAD

WHEREAS, The Texas Department of Transportation is constructing transportation improvements on US 59 at Doris Road including a four-lane grade separation, two lane access road, and reconstruction of the two-lane frontage road at a cost of \$25,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, that project is part of a larger project to widen US 59 to six main lanes and two-lane frontage roads from Spur 10 to the Wharton County Line; and

WHEREAS, these improvements, once made, will improve mobility for the citizens of Fort Bend County, the general public, and for goods movement and provide a safer roadway on which to commute; and

WHEREAS, without a local roadway connection to the new bridge over Doris Road, mobility for the residents of Fort Bend County may be impeded; and


WHEREAS, the Doris Road is a major thoroughfare and the Doris Road Overpass is a project in Fort Bend County's 2013 Mobility Bond Program; and

WHEREAS, Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas believes it is in the best interest of its residence to construct a new roadway to connect to the bridge on US 59 at Doris Road, and finds such construction serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas agrees, with no participation from the Texas Department of Transportation, will complete design and construct a roadway tying into the US 59 bridge over Doris Road; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County Texas will complete construction of the roadway within five years of the completion of the bridge over US 59 by the Texas Department of Transportation.
