

2. Slowness in the process of picking up the trash is impeding the progress of construction, can the county or city help?
3. What happens to the homes of those walking away and not doing anything to remediate or rebuild their properties?
4. Does FEMA have any buy out provisions?
5. What will be the CAD proposal for flood victims for taxes this year?
6. Septic systems – do those who have the old systems HAVE to update to aerobic?
7. Why does this 1 person (FEMA Lawyer or engineer) hold the future for so many? We and others' have insurance companies that have assigned engineers to check the structure of our homes, what if our engineer has a conflict with yours – how is this resolved?
8. Questions of the aquifer being contaminated as so many have chlorinated their wells more than 5 times and are still not passing? Why and what can be done?
9. Per your report on line, page 4 – Items to be excluded: POST storm debris, then why did that FEMA lawyer say that removal and remediation count for part of our 50% in the city council meeting last Tuesday?
10. What about those who do not have access to the info on the Simonton website, there should be signs at each entrance telling residents to seek this information and permit approvals, what will happen to those?
11. Looters, many are still being broken into, can we pay local residents who are police to help protect our homes as we start to rebuild? WE DESPARATELY need help and to have something in force as we start purchasing valuables to rebuild for our homes.
12. For some of us the only way that we can stay under the 50% is if we act as our own contractors, do we then give the city copies of our quotes from the individual contractors that we plan on using before we begin, do they have to be approved if they are licensed by the state? If they are not?
