EXTENSION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER DECLARATION  
 FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER

WHEREAS, on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2016, the County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a local state of disaster for Fort Bend County, Texas, resulting from the threat of imminent disaster from extensive rain resulting in flooding; and

WHEREAS, on June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2016, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, as its governing body, continued the Order of a local state of disaster for an additional fourteen (14) days, effective June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016 pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the declaration of a local state of disaster continue to exist; and


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, as its governing body, desires to continue the order of a local state of disaster for an additional twenty-eight (28) days pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT of FORT BEND COUNTY:

1. That the local state of disaster ordered for Fort Bend County, Texas, by the County Judge on May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2016, and continued by order of the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court on June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2016, but effective as of June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016; and continued on July 17, 2016, but effective on July 18, 2016; and continued again on June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2016, and effective on June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2016; shall further continue for an additional twenty-eight (28) days through August 23, 2016.
2. This order is passed as an emergency measure pursuant §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code and shall become effective on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2016.
