Project Abstract

The Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office NIBRS conversion project is to update our existing software Tiburon's environment configuration from the current UCR reporting to the required NIBRS statistical reporting. NIBRS reporting will be mandatory by 2019; however, we are striving to complete this conversion as soon as possible to deliver the required data faster, more efficient, and more effective.

The existing service system is based on manual operation and paper documents that are used to report current data. Tiburon's record engineers will provide the services to apply NIBRS to the existing environment. Included in this project is the implementation of new applications, user menu updates, updates to code/parameters, internal testing, and documentation of the complete process.

After implementation, the updated environment will keep data numbers on crimes and provide the tools for analyzing those numbers as well as generating the required flat file to DPS.
