



Item 2 continued - Discussion:

Judge Hebert stated, for the record, this item called for a special meeting due to the floods in Louisiana and the limited temporary housing available across the nation. Louisiana currently has 10,000 pending applications and Fort Bend County wanted to make sure this area's needs were met first since the flooding occurred here first. There is no County match and this program is provided by the Federal Government to those who qualify. Direct Housing allows an individual to have temporary housing while their domicile is being repaired. Also, a diligent effort must be shown to restore the property.

Jeff Braun, Emergency Management Coordinator, stated this resolution does not indicate the County would participate in the buy program. Rosenberg, Simonton and Thompsons have indicated they are good with no sales program.
