

From the USACE Galveston District, head north on I-45. Take exit 32 for Sam Houston Tollway W. Head west on Sam Houston Tollway. Take exit for S Post Oak Road. Head south on S Post Oak Road. Turn right onto Farm-to-Market Road 2234 (McHard Road). The tract is on the left located south of the existing Chimney Rock Road.

18. Nature of Activity (Description of project, include all features)

In order to construct the proposed project, the Applicant proposes to fill 0.34 acre of jurisdictional adjacent wetlands and 20 square feet of non-vegetated Waters of the U.S. in order to extend the existing Chimney Rock Road within a 39.73 acre (~11,700 linear feet) tract of land.

19. Project Purpose (Describe the reason or purpose of the project, see instructions)

The purpose of the proposed fill activity is to extend Chimney Rock Road. The proposed Chimney Rock Road Extension will provide a direct connection between McHard Road (FM 2234) and Trammel Fresno Road, and complete the connection between State Highway (SH) 6 and the Sam Houston Tollway. This roadway connection is needed to in order to meet the growing transportation demands associated with future population growth in this region of Fort Bend County.

The Applicant proposes to purchase the appropriate number of mitigation credits for the secondary service area of Danza Del Rio Mitigation Bank to compensate for the impacts to Waters of the U.S. Though only the southern end of the proposed project site is within the secondary service area for this bank, mitigation bank credits are the preferred method of compensation. The proposed project is entirely within the secondary service area of the Lower Brazos River Mitigation Bank, but this bank does not currently have sufficient credits to compensate for the proposed project, and we do not know at this time when credits would become available.
