LEGISLATION PROHIBITING SELLING GOODS ON COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY

WHEREAS, roadsides in unincorporated Fort Bend County become congested with roadside vendors;
and,

WHEREAS, roadside vendors pose a hazard to drivers, pedestrians, and neighborhoods alike; and,


WHEREAS, Texas Transportation Code 285.001 allows for the Commissioners Courts in counties with a population of 1.3 million or more the ability to prohibit roadside vending in the unincorporated portions of the counties; and,

WHEREAS, drivers and pedestrians in Fort Bend County would see an immediate benefit by removing this hazardous act away from roadsides; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, finds that this resolution serves a public purpose.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, Fort Bend County supports its inclusion in Texas Transportation Code 285.001.
