




WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas has found that the case load and public need and necessity requires that an additional General Jurisdiction Judicial District Court be created by the 85th Legislature sitting in Austin, Travis County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas has found that the creation of an additional General Jurisdiction Judicial District Court would serve a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas does hereby request that the 85th Legislature create an additional Judicial District Court in the ensuing legislative year, to be effective September 1, 2017.
