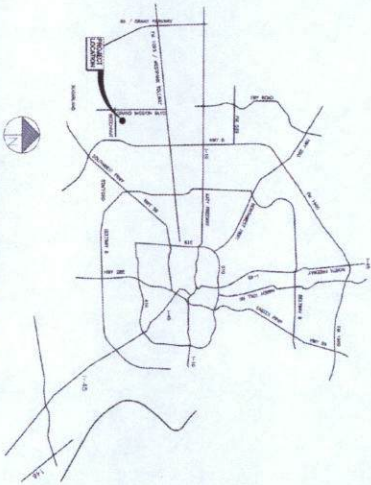

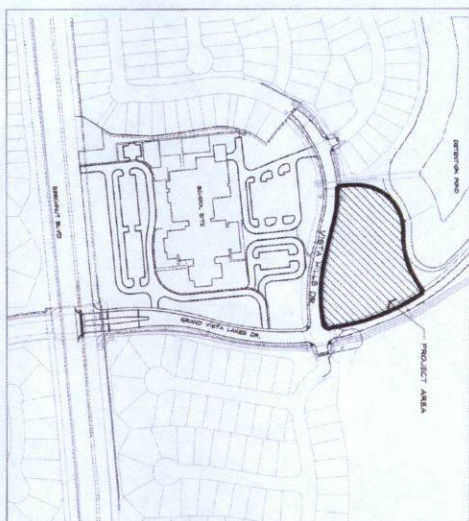

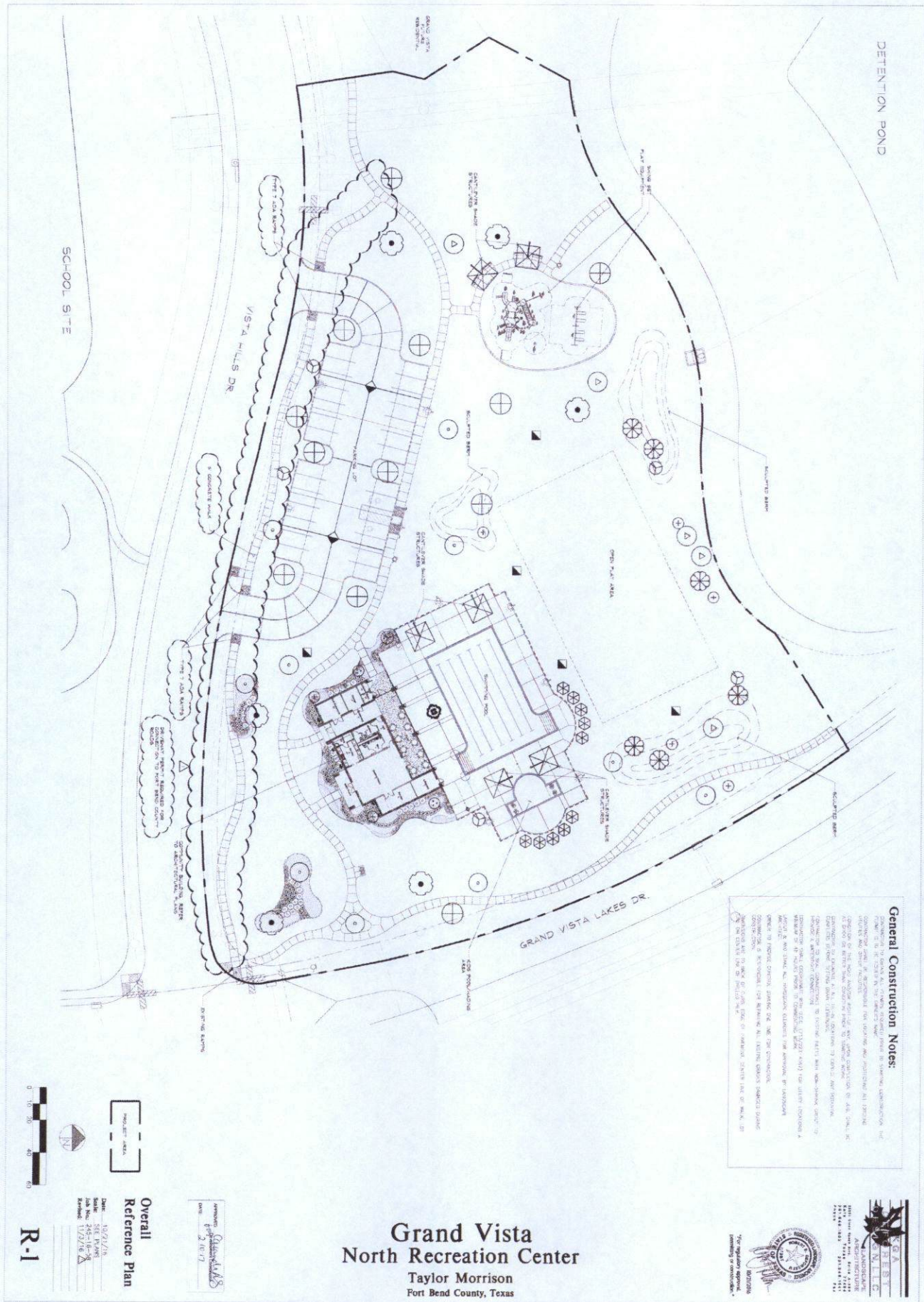

14. *Limiting factor* is a factor that limits the rate of a process.
