ORDER IMPOSING SALES AND USE TAXES

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2017, Fort Bend County (the "County") held an election for the creation of Fort Bend County Assistance District No. 11 (the "District") and the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of two percent within the boundaries of the District; and

WHEREAS, the County certified the results of the election on May 9, 2017, in which the voters authorized the creation of the District and the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of two percent within the boundaries of the District; and

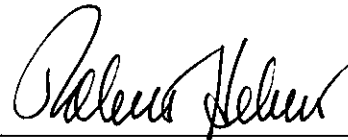
WHEREAS, Chapter 387 of the Texas Local Government Code permits the District to impose a sales and use tax to finance the operations of the District; Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1: A sales and use tax of two percent is hereby imposed within the boundaries of the District, in order to finance the operations of the District or for any other purposes authorized by law, commencing on the first day of the first calendar quarter occurring after the expiration of the first complete quarter occurring after the date the State Comptroller receives a copy of this Order, anticipated to be October 1, 2017.

Section 2: This Order is effective immediately upon passage.
