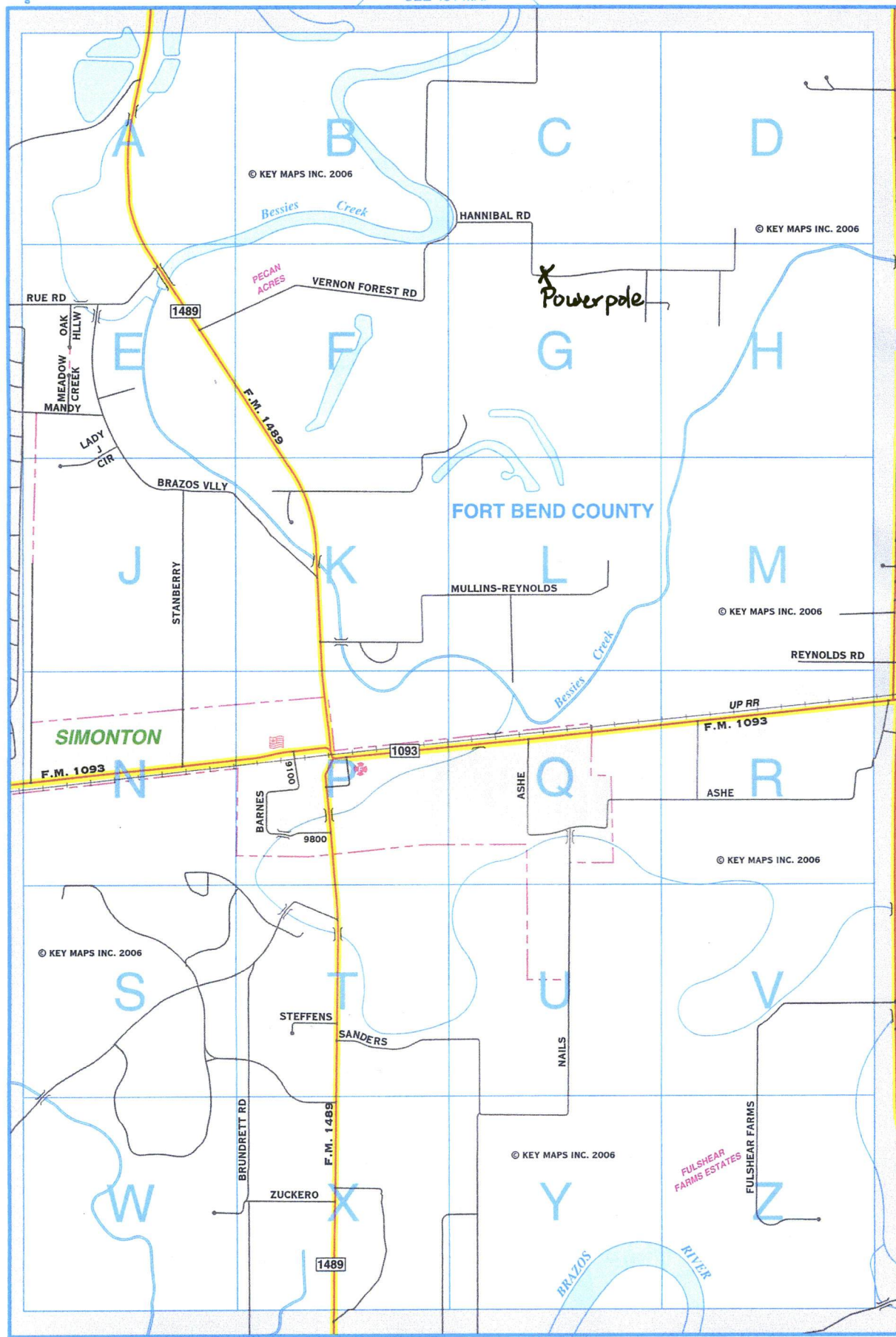

# **TENNESSEE GAS PIPELINE COMPANY, L.L.C.**

## **SCOPE OF WORK**

Kinder Morgan Proposes to install a Powerpole in the Ft. Bend County Road Right of Way for the purposes of Cathodic Protection to its pipeline on the Southside of Hannibal Rd. approximately 120' +/- (120) Feet West from where Hunt Ln. intersects Hannibal Rd.

Kinder Morgan will be drilling a 10 inch diameter hole 300 feet deep at location for cathodic protection. The well will house 12 1"X36" MMO anodes with #8 HALAR HMWPE header cables. Header cables will be trenched from the groundbed location underground approx. 24-36" deep and tied into a junction box on the rectifier pole. A Pole will be installed outside the land owner fence to hang a cathodic protection Rectifier and anode junction box, to provide DC power to the installed groundbed, resulting in corrosion prevention on the pipe line as per 49 CFR 192. A Drill Star 5200 (32 feet long by 8 feet wide) will be drilling the hole with a 5 ton (28 feet long by 8 feet wide) 3K gallon capacity water truck supporting. The amount of water used to install Ground Bed will be approx 4K gallons. Other equipment used will be 3 3/4 ton trucks and a rubber tire John Deer 410 backhoe, and a Hydro-vac truck. Company policy states that we will use Hydro-vac as an exploratory method to "Pot Hole" up to 15' deep before any mechanical means of excavation can be used. Work will be conducted on Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company Right of Way inside the land owner property line, not to encroach on County Rd.

No Traffic Control Plan required.
