

**ORDER AUTHORIZING LITIGATION**

On this 6 day of June, 2017, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, being convened at a regular meeting of the Court, sitting as the governing body of Fort Bend County, upon motion of Commissioner Patterson, seconded by Commissioner Meyers, duly put and carried, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The Fort Bend County Attorney's Office is hereby authorized to file a lawsuit on behalf of Fort Bend County, Texas and/or the State of Texas against Lorenzo DeCamps for any and all monetary damages caused to Fort Bend County, Texas and/or the State of Texas, for any and all civil penalties payable to and/or enforceable by Fort Bend County, Texas or the State of Texas, by reason of the violation of the Fort Bend County Regulations for Floodplain Management and the violation of the Fort Bend County Driveway Permit Regulations as noted in correspondence from the Fort Bend County Engineering Department to Lorenzo DeCamps dated March 23, 2017 and as continuing thereafter or related thereto, and for any and all injunctive, declaratory, or equitable relief as allowed by law by reason of such violations; and the County Attorney's Office is hereby authorized to seek the full measure of monetary damages and all recoverable elements thereof, as well as any other appropriate legal and equitable relief, including but not limited to actual damages, consequential damages, additional damages, statutory damages and penalties, exemplary damages and/or punitive damages, attorney's fees, litigation expenses, pre-judgment interest, court costs, interest on the judgment, collection costs, temporary and permanent injunctive, declaratory, or equitable relief, and other relief to which the County may be entitled.
