

In connection with obligations in favor of the Kentucky Department of Highways only, it is agreed that the power and authority hereby given to the Attorney-in-Fact cannot be modified or revoked unless prior written personal notice of such intent has been given to the Commissioner-Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Kentucky at least thirty (30) days prior to the modification or revocation.

TCP 11-20

1. R1-2 "YIELD" sign traffic control may be used on projects with approaches that have adequate sight distance. For projects in urban areas, work spaces should be no longer than one half city block. In rural areas on roadways with less than 2000 ADT, work spaces should be no longer than 400 feet.
2. R1-3 "YIELD" sign with R1-6a "TO OVERTAKE TRAFFIC" plaque shall be placed on a support of 0.7 foot minimum mounting height.

TCP (1-2b)

13. **Flaggers should use two-way radios or other methods of communication to control traffic.**
14. **Length of work spaces should be based on the ability of flaggers to communicate.**
15. **If the work space is located near a bar, restaurant, or wet/dry storage, the buffer distance should be increased in order to maintain adequate stopping sight distance to the flagger.**
16. **Flaggers should wear reflective safety vests and reflective traffic wands.**
17. **Communication devices should be used and be activated when a pilot car is leading traffic and approved by the Engineer.**
18. **Flaggers should use 24" STOP/GO/Advance to control traffic. Flag should be limited to emergency situations.**
