2017 Chili Cook-Off Donation Distribution

On total donations of -----\$52,893.00

1. Voting monies collected in jars for Police, Constables and Fire/EMS --- \$512.15
2. 20% of the total donations after taking out the voting donations, go to the Sheriff's Dept., the Constables Precinct 1, 2, 3, 4 and The 100 Club. This computes as follows; $\$52,893.00 - \$512.16 = \$52,380.84 \times 20\%$ or \$10,476.18. This amount is Divided equally @ 16.67% share to each of these 6 beneficiaries;

a. Sheriff's Department -----	\$1746.03
b. Constables Precinct 1 -----	\$1746.03
c. Constables Precinct 2 ---\$1746.03 + vote money \$46.00-----	\$1792.03
d. Constables Precinct 3 -----	\$1746.03
e. Constables Precinct 4 -----	\$1746.03
f. The 100 Club -----	\$1746.03

3. 80% of the total donations after taking out the voting donations, go to the Police and Fire/EMS Associations of Sugar Land, Missouri City, Rosenberg, Stafford, Richmond and Meadows Place. Each cities donation is calculated based on percentage of their population to total population, which is 233,161 persons. This computes as follows; $\$52,893.00 - 512.16 = \$52,380.84 \times 80\%$ or \$41,904.67. Donations to each city will be split equally between Police and Fire/EMS excepting Meadows Place which does not have its own separate Fire/Ems. Those donation amounts are;

- a. Sugar Land population is 88,156 or 37.81% of total population. $37.81\% \times \$41,904.67 = \$15,844.16 / 2 = \$7922.08$ each for SLPOA and SL Fire/EMS.

SLPOA $\$7922.08 - \4880.00 (funds collected per Marty) = $\$3042.08 + \99.00 vote monies = \$3141.08 total donation to be funded.

Sugar Land Fire/EMS $\$7922.08 + \79.00 vote monies = \$8001.08 total donation to be funded.

- b. Missouri City population is 74,139 or 31.80% of total population. $31.80\% \times \$41,904.67 = \$13325.68 / 2 = \$6662.84$ each for MCPOA and MC Fire/Ems

MCPOA $\$6662.84 + \56.40 vote monies = \$6719.24 total donation to be funded.

Missouri City Fire/EMS $\$6662.84 + \43.00 vote monies = \$6705.84 total
