Re: 2<sup>nd</sup> Extension Letter and Revised Exhibit "A" to Interlocal Agreement Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Program: Houston Metropolitan Area

District Attorney Healey:

The City Houston, acting through the Houston Police Department (HPD) and Fort Bend County, acting through Fort Bend County District Attorney's Office, entered into an Interlocal Agreement in May 2016 providing for use of Grant Funds received by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) for funding the Houston Metro Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force. Exhibit "A" of the Agreement provided for reimbursement of salary expenses for an investigator.

The Agreement also allows the HPD Chief of Police to extend the Agreement provided that Grant funds continue to be available. The parties acknowledged in the Agreement that the amounts provided in Exhibit "A" may change as the City's application for renewal of Grant funding in future years is reviewed by OJJDP. It was further understood and agreed that any application for additional Grant funds over and above those amounts shown in Exhibit "A" shall first be approved by the City and the Fort Bend County District Attorney's Office and be in accordance with the effective GRANT APPLICATION AND ADMINISTRATION GUIDELINES of the OJJDP.

The OJDDP has extended the project period to end September 30, 2017, and additional Grant funds over and above the amounts shown in the current Exhibit "A" have been approved by OJJDP for funding salary, overtime, a leased vehicle and fuel for the Fort Bend County District Attorney's office for three months beginning July 1, 2017 to September 30, 2017.
