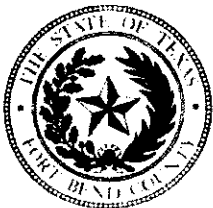

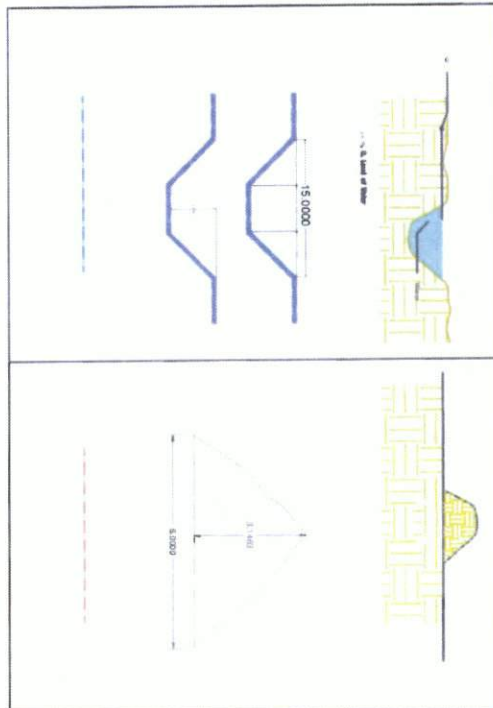

Sean,

The Drainage District has reviewed the attached site plan for the property at 33058 Rogers Road. The site is adjacent to Brookshire Creek and is within Zone "A" on the FEMA FIRM maps, so floodplain fill mitigation and conveyance mitigation were a concern.

The original plan called for a berm to be constructed across the full length and width of the property along Rogers Road and Pool Hill Road. To avoid blocking conveyance along Brookshire Creek and natural drainage pathways along Pool Hill Road, the owner agreed to only construct the berm west of the existing driveway and south of the existing pond (red line on attached layout). Per the attached email, all the dirt used to construct the berm will be excavated from a proposed ditch from the existing pond to the creek (blue line on attached layout), so no outside fill will be brought into the floodplain.

The proposed pipe from the ditch to Brookshire Creek should be coordinated with the Drainage District maintenance section. The property owner will be required to purchase the materials, and the Drainage District will install the pipe. The Drainage District has no objection to the proposed work as described above.
