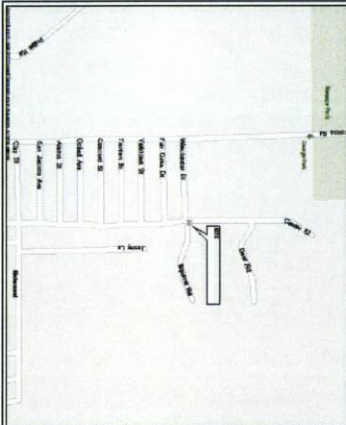

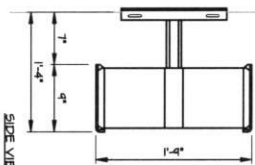

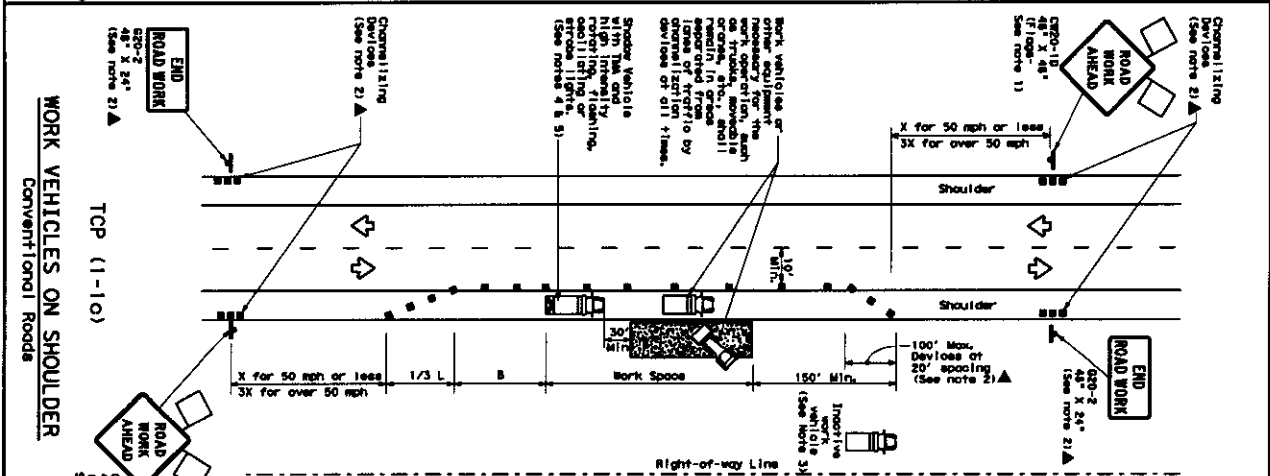
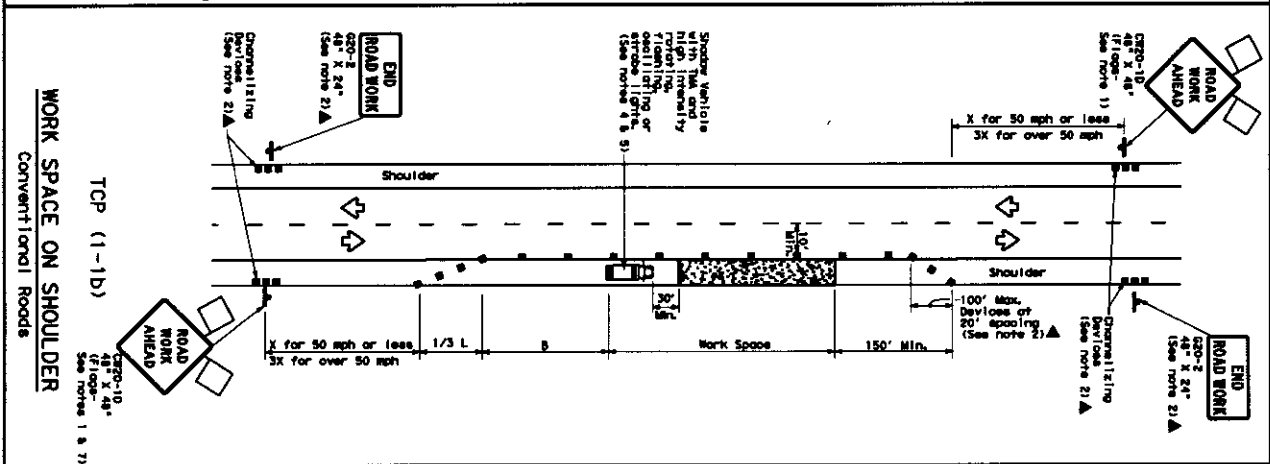
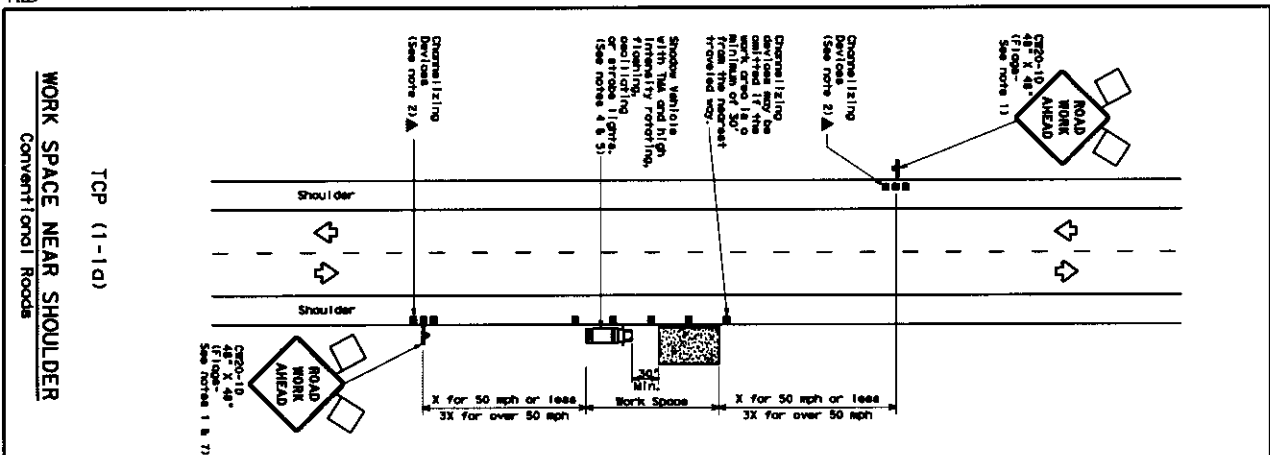
GROUND BED DETAILS
