1. **Call to Order.**

2. **Workshop to discuss any pending action that may be necessary on the impact of the current disaster declaration initiated August 24, 2017 as a result of Tropical Storm (Hurricane) Harvey.**

Judge Hebert gave an overview of the current status from the impact of Tropical Storm (Hurricane) Harvey. He stated the Brazos River is going down. Judge Hebert indicated Harlem, 90A, Pitts and 99 at 90A are now opened. Orders are being modified on Voluntary and Mandatory Evacuations. The initial recovery is on its way. Debris can be put out between the sidewalk and the curb and the County will pick up the debris in unincorporated areas. Residents can go to www.fbcoem.org to find how debris should be stacked. Residents, whose homes had water, should fill out an application with FEMA at www.FEMA.gov.
