Call to Order by Judge Hebert at 1:00 p.m.

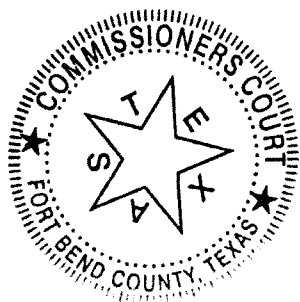


Judge Hebert gave an overview of the impact of the current disaster as a result of Tropical Storm (Hurricane) Harvey. He gave an update on the San Bernard River, the Brazos River and Barker Reservoir. Judge Hebert will not reverse the Mandatory and Voluntary evacuations until the rivers are below their crest stage. At this point, the County is still in rescue mode. A meeting will be set for tomorrow, August 31, 2017, at 1:00 p.m.
