**WHEREAS**, Fort Bend County's nominated candidate(s) serve a two-year term on the Board of Directors of the Fort Bend Central Appraisal District, for a term of office extending through December 31, 2019, and

**WHEREAS**, Fort Bend County desires to nominate candidates to represent Fort Bend County on the Board of Directors of the Appraisal District.

**William F. Schwer**

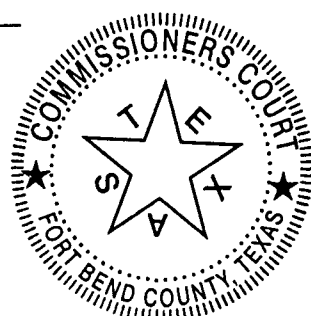

Dear Sir or Madam,

The conservation and reclamation districts have voted and selected Sam Mayson as the candidate to be placed on the general election ballot. He received 74% of the 645 timely filed votes.

The current serving board members, Al Abramczyk, Jim Kij, Paul Stamatis, and Rhonda Zacharias have agreed to serve another term if nominated and elected.

The election calendar for the 2018-2019 Board of Directors election is as follows:

- On or before October 30, a ballot will be sent to each voting entity listing each candidate in alphabetical order by their surname and their number of votes they have to cast.
- The governing body of each taxing unit entitled to vote shall determine its vote by resolution and submit it to the Chief Appraiser before December 15, 2017.
- The votes will be tallied on December 15<sup>th</sup>. The results will be announced at the next regular Board of Directors meeting. The five (5) candidates who receive the largest cumulative vote totals will be declared elected.
- On December 20<sup>th</sup>, formal notification of the results will be sent to each voting entity and all of the candidates.
- During the January 2018 regular monthly meeting, the Oath of Office and election of officers will be given.

Please remember that all votes must be done by resolution, which has to be signed, dated and delivered to the Chief Appraiser no later than close of business on December 15. Any ballots received after that deadline will not be counted.

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**RE: Right to Nominate a Person to Serve as a Director of the District**

Dear Sir or Madam,

In accordance with the Texas Property Code, Section 6.03(g) – Board of Directors, each taxing unit other than a conservation and reclamation district that is entitled to vote may nominate by resolution adopted by its governing body one candidate for each position to be filled on the Board of Directors. The presiding officer of the governing body of the unit shall submit the names of the unit's nominees to the chief appraiser before October 15.

Before October 30, the chief appraiser shall prepare a ballot, listing the candidates whose names were timely submitted under as set by the property tax code in subsections (g) and, if applicable, (h) or (i) alphabetically according to the first letter in each candidate's surname, and shall deliver a copy of the ballot to the presiding officer of the governing body of each taxing unit that is entitled to vote.

The following current Board of Directors have agreed to serve another term if elected:

- Jim Kij, Chairman
- Paul Stamatis, Jr., Vice-Chairman
- Rhonda Zacharias, Secretary
- Al Abramczyk, Financial Officer

The conservation and reclamation districts have placed Sam Mayson as their candidate.
